



All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

Thursday 08 December 2022
Time of Issue: 1930 hours IST

(NIGHT)

08 Dec (Day 1): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema.

♦ **Gale wind**, speed reaching 80-90 kmph gusting to 100 kmph, likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal during 08th noon to 08th night. **Squally wind**, speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph, likely to commence along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts from 08th December afternoon. **Squally wind, speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph**, likely over Gulf of Mannar from 08th December evening and Squally wind, speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph, is likely to prevail over Southeast Bay of Bengal on 8th Dec. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Punjab.

09 Dec (Day 2): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** with **extremely heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over north coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over north interior Tamilnadu and adjoining south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka and Kerala.

♦ **Gale wind**, 75-85 kmph gusting to 95 kmph likely over Southwest Bay of Bengal from 9th morning and 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph from 9th December evening. **Squally wind**, speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely to prevail along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts from 9th December morning and 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph from 09th December evening to early hours of 10th December and 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely over Gulf of Mannar from 09th December evening to early hours of 10th December and 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph by 10th December morning. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Punjab and Haryana.

10 Dec (Day 3): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over north Tamilnadu, Rayalaseema and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala.

♦ **Squally wind**, speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph likely to prevail along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts by morning of 10th December and then reduce to 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph by 10th December night. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets likely over Punjab and Haryana.

11 Dec (Day 4): ♦ **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over South Interior Karnataka.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets likely over Punjab and Haryana.


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12 Dec (Day 5): ♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets likely over Punjab and Haryana.



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IMPACT EXPECTED & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO Very Heavy/Extremely heavy rainfall at isolated over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 08th-10th; over Rayalaseema on 09th & 10th and over south coastal Andhra Pradesh on 09th December, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized water logging in low lying areas in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutchra roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

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
