All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

05 May (Day 1):

- Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & squally winds (speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema; with lightning at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; heavy rainfall at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, Konkan, Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.
- Heat wave conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Gangetic West Bengal, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Telangana and Interior Karnataka.
- Warm night conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Coastal Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka.
- Squally wind (speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) very likely to prevail along and off south Andhra Pradesh coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

06 May (Day 2):

- Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & squally winds (speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Odisha, Rayalaseema and Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Telangana; with lightning at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Marathwada and Karnataka.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura with isolated extremely heavy falls over Meghalaya; heavy rainfall at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh and Gangetic West Bengal.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Konkan, Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.
- Heat wave conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Chhattisgarh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Telangana and Interior Karnataka.
- Warm night conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Coastal Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka.
- Squally wind (speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) very likely to prevail along and off Odisha, West Bengal & Andhra Pradesh coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.





07 May (Day 3):

- Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & squally winds (speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph) likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar and East Madhya Pradesh; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) & hail at isolated places over Interior Karnataka; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema and Telangana; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe; with lightning at isolated places over Coastal Karnataka, Assam & Meghalaya.
- Heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema.
- Heat wave conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Interior Karnataka.
- Warm night conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Coastal Karnataka and South Interior Karnataka.
- Squally wind (speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) likely to prevail along and off Odisha, West Bengal & north Andhra Pradesh coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

08 May (Day 4):

- Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & squally winds (speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph) likely at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) & hail at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh , West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Telangana and North Interior Karnataka; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Uttarakhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe; with lightning at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Karnataka.
- ✤ Heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.
- Heat wave conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Rajasthan, Saurashtra & Kutch, West Madhya Pradesh.
- Squally wind (speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) likely to prevail along and off Odisha & West Bengal coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

09 May (Day 5):


- Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & squally winds (speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph) likely at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) & hail at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka; with lightning, gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh , West Madhya Pradesh , Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Telangana and North Interior Karnataka; with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Uttarakhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe; with lightning at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Karnataka.
- Heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.
- Heat wave conditions very likely to prevail in isolated pockets over Rajasthan, Saurashtra & Kutch, West Madhya Pradesh.
- Squally wind (speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) likely to prevail along and off Odisha & West Bengal coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.



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

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IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to Heat Wave Conditions:

Red alert Areas

- ✓ Very high likelihood of developing heat illness and heat stroke in all ages.
- ✓ Extreme care needed for vulnerable people.

Orange alert Areas

- ✓ High temperature & increased likelihood of heat illness symptoms in people who are either exposed to sun for a prolonged period or doing heavy work.
- ✓ High health concern for vulnerable people e.g. infants, elderly, people with chronic diseases.
- ✓ Avoid heat exposure− keep cool. Avoid dehydration.
- ✓ Drink sufficient water- even if not thirsty.
- ✓ Use ORS, homemade drinks like lassi, torani (rice water), lemon water, buttermilk, etc. to keep yourself hydrated.

Yellow alert Areas

- ✓ Moderate temperature & heat is tolerable for general public but moderate health concern likely for vulnerable people e.g. infants, elderly, people with chronic diseases.
- ✓ Avoid heat exposure.
- ✓ Wear lightweight, light colour, loose, cotton clothes.
- ✓ Cover your head, use a cloth, hat or umbrella.





Impact & Action Suggested due to Isolated heavy/very heavy rainfall over Sikkim on 05th; Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 05th-07th; Gangetic West Bengal on 06th & 07th; Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema on 07th and Tamil Nadu, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala on 07th & 08th May, 2024.

Impacts Expected for Rainfall/Snowfall over above regions:

- ✓ Disruption of Electricity.
- ✓ Landslide, rock fall and mudslides, Blocking/washout of roads/highways/bridges Nallahs.
- ✓ Disruption of traffic flow.
- ✓ Damage to Kuccha and unsecured structures.

Suggested Actions

- ✓ Avoid roadway underpasses, drainage ditches, low lying areas and areas where water collects they can unexpectedly flood or overflow.
- ✓ Stay away from power lines or electrical wires.
- ✓ Don't stay in kuchcha houses during heavy rainfall as it may collapse anytime soon.
- ✓ Drive carefully.

Agromet advisories for Heavy Rainfall, Gusty winds and Heat Wave likely over various parts of the country:

- Make necessary arrangements for draining out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in North-Eastern States and Sikkim.
- > In Arunachal Pradesh, postpone sowing of *Jhum* paddy, maize and soybean.
- Apply light and frequent irrigation to standing crops to avoid heat stress; provide mulching to conserve soil moisture and minimise evaporation in Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Interior Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops & staking to vegetables to prevent damage from gusty winds.
