



All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

Saturday 21 May 2022

Time of Issue: 1945 hours IST

(NIGHT)

21 May (Day 1): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** with **extremely heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Meghalaya; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Assam and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal-Sikkim, Karnataka and Kerala-Mahe.

♦ **Thunder squall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) & hail** at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand; **with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Gangetic West Bengal and Andaman & Nicobar Islands; **gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Telangana and with **lightning** at isolated places over Jharkhand, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh-Yanam, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Heat wave conditions** in isolated pockets very likely over Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand.

♦ **Dust storm/thunderstorm/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over East Rajasthan.

♦ **Squally weather (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** very likely along and off North Kerala-south Karnataka coasts and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea, North Andaman Sea and Eastcentral Bay of Bengal. **Strong wind** with speed of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Northeast Arabian Sea & adjoining north Gujarat coast and Southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

22 May (Day 2): ♦ **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal-Sikkim, Bihar, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thundersquall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 50-60 kmph) & hail** at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal-Sikkim; **with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph) & hail** at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and Punjab; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) & hail** at isolated places over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad; **thundersquall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal and Andaman & Nicobar Islands; **thunderstorm with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** at isolated places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and Jharkhand; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Bihar and with **lightning** at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Dust storm/thunderstorm/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Rajasthan.

♦ **Squally weather (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** very likely along and off North Kerala-south Karnataka coasts and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea, North Andaman Sea and Eastcentral Bay of Bengal. **Strong wind** with speed of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Northeast Arabian Sea & adjoining north Gujarat coast and Southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

23 May (Day 3): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Thundersquall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 50-60 kmph) & hail** at isolated places very likely over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and East Rajasthan; **thunderstorm with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph) & hail** at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh; **thundersquall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places over Uttarakhand and Andaman & Nicobar Islands and West Rajasthan; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** at isolated places over Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Bihar and with **lightning** at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal-Sikkim, Odisha, Telangana, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Dust storm/thunderstorm/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Rajasthan.

♦ **Squally weather (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** very likely along and off North Kerala-south Karnataka coasts and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea, North Andaman Sea and Eastcentral & westcentral Bay of Bengal. **Strong wind** with speed of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

24 May (Day 4): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Thundersquall accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands; **thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and Jharkhand; **gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Gangetic West Bengal and with **lightning** at isolated places over Bihar, Odisha, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Dust storm/thunderstorm/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Rajasthan.

♦ **Squally weather (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph)** likely over north Andaman Sea, Eastcentral & southwest Bay of Bengal. **Strong wind** with speed of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these area.

25 May (Day 5): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph) at isolated places likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands; **gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh and with **lightning** at isolated places over Jharkhand, Odisha, Telangana, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.



EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to heavy to very heavy/extremely heavy rainfall over Assam & Meghalaya on 20th & 21st May.

Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to **horticulture and standing crops** in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to Thundersquall with lightning/hail over Jammu & Kashmir on 22nd; over Himachal Pradesh & Punjab on 22nd & 23rd; over Uttarakhand on 21st & 22nd; over Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi on 23rd and over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal on 22nd May, 2022.

Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

Action suggested:

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- Farming operations may be suspended during the event.
