



All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

Friday 24 June 2022

(NIGHT)

24 June (Day 1): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Coastal Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Bihar, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat state, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat state, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over east central Arabian Sea, along and off south Gujarat, Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka-Kerala coasts and Lakshadweep area. **Strong winds** of 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely over south west Arabian Sea and adjoining west central Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

25 June (Day 2): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, south Gujarat state and Coastal Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat state, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) very likely along and off south Gujarat coast; (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over east central Arabian Sea, along and off Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala coasts and Lakshadweep area. **Strong winds** of 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely over south west Arabian Sea and adjoining west central Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

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26 June (Day 3): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Coastal Karnataka, Konkan & Goa and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Gujarat state, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) very likely along and off south Gujarat coast; (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over east central Arabian Sea, along and off Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala coasts and Lakshadweep area. **Strong winds** of 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely over south west Arabian Sea and adjoining west central Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

27 June (Day 4): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Konkan & Goa, Gujarat State, Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand, East Rajasthan and **with lightning** at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) likely over east central Arabian Sea, along and off south Maharashtra, Goa coasts. **Strong winds** of 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph likely over south west Arabian Sea and adjoining west central Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

28 June (Day 5): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand, East Rajasthan and **with lightning** at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

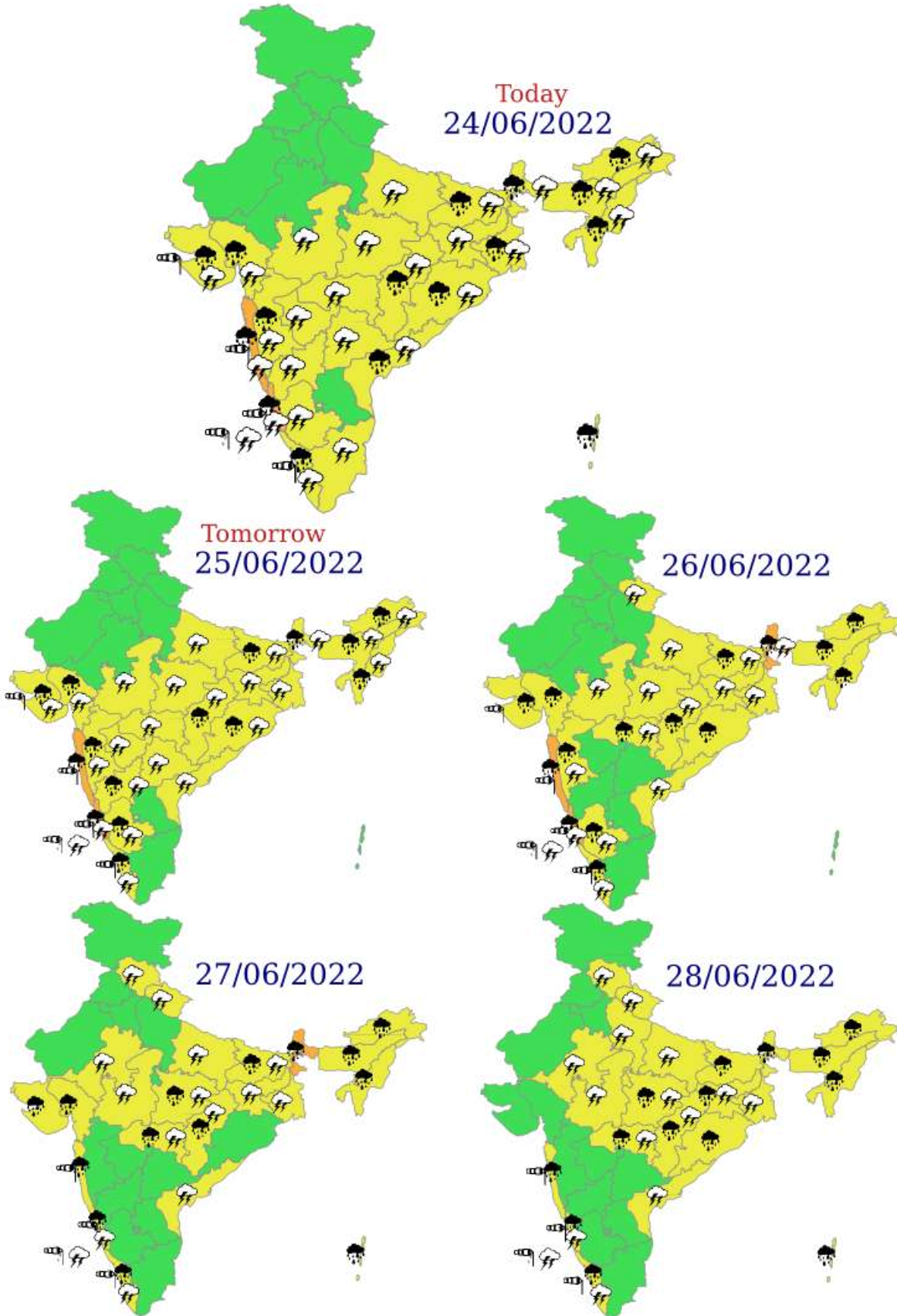
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EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to very heavy rainfall over Konkan & Goa and Coastal Karnataka during next 3 days.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

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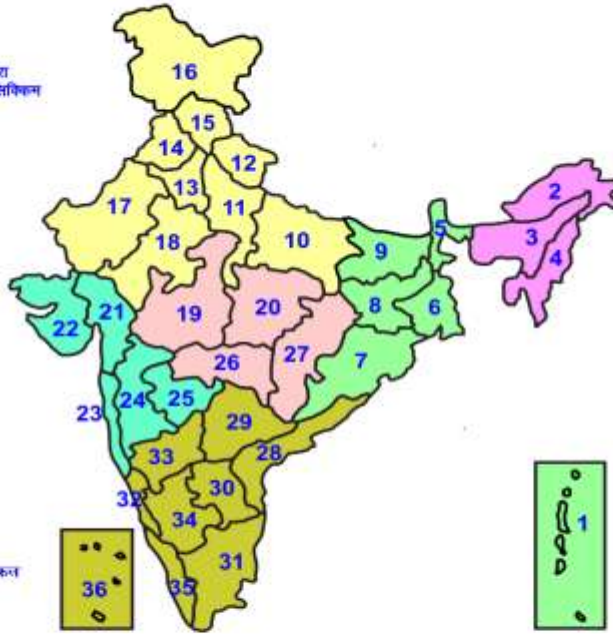
