06 Aug (Day 1): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls very likely at isolated places over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Odisha, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan & Goa, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat State, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thundersquall (speed reaching 50-60 kmph)** very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands; **thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Telangana and **thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat state, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

07 Aug (Day 2): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana and Coastal & South Interior Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat State, Marathwada, North Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

08 Aug (Day 3): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls** very likely at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Telangana, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Gangetic West Bengal, Gujarat State and Coastal & South Interior Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, North Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

09 Aug (Day 4): ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places with **extremely heavy falls** likely at isolated places over Konkan & Goa; **heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls** at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Gujarat Region, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Telangana; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Gangetic West Bengal, Saurashtra & Kutch, Marathwada and Coastal & South Interior Karnataka and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over West Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, North Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.

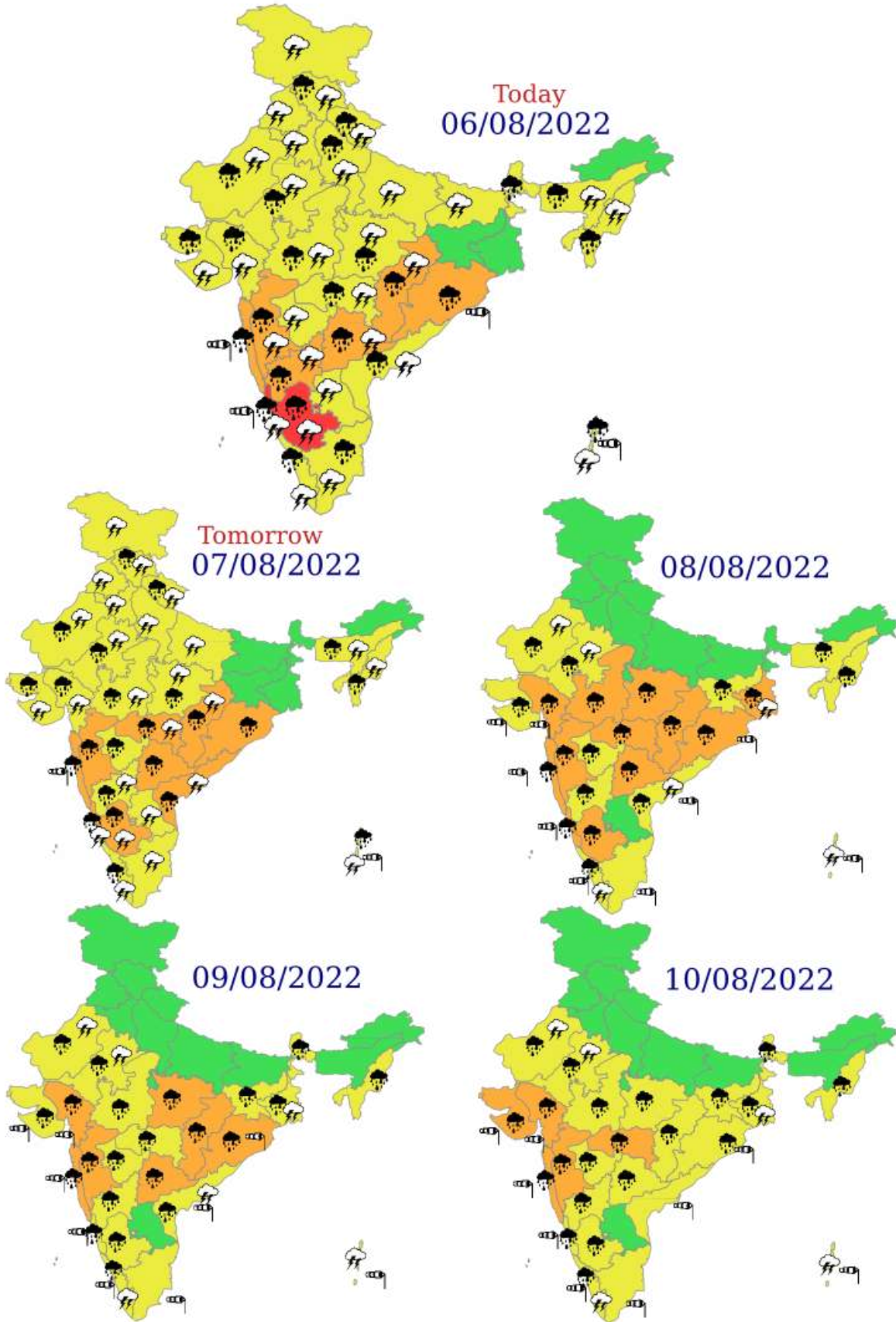

EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 06th and over Odisha, Chhattisgarh & Telangana on 8th & 9th, East Madhya Pradesh on 09th; Vidarbha on 10th; Konkan & Goa and ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during 08th-10th; Gujarat Region on 09th & 10th; Saurashtra & Kutch on 10th August, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

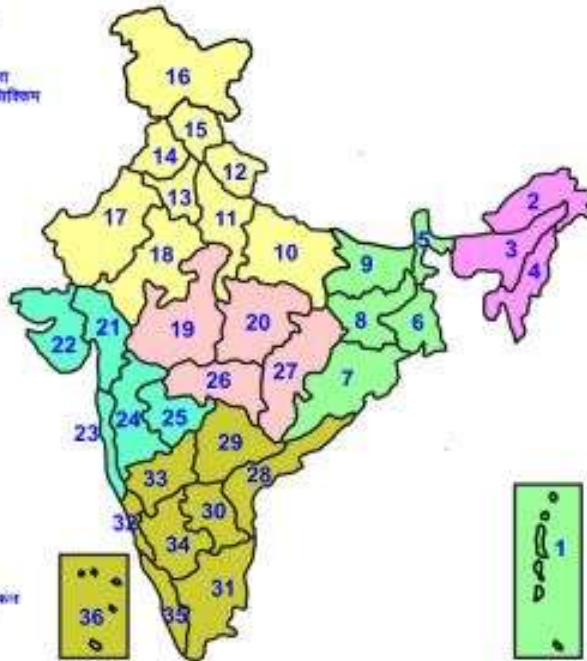
