(NIGHT)

22 Sept (Day 1): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over West Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan; ; **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, East Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Gujarat Region, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat Region, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana.

♦ **Squally winds** of 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over southwest and adjoining west-central Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast, Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area and south Tamil Nadu. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

23 Sept (Day 2): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat Region, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana.

♦ **Squally winds** of 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over southwest and adjoining west-central Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast, Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area and south Tamil Nadu. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

24 Sept (Day 3): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar.

♦ **Squally winds** of 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over southwest and adjoining west-central Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

25 Sept (Day 4): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim.

♦ **Squally winds** of 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over southwest and adjoining west-central Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these seas.

26 Sept (Day 5): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over East Uttar Pradesh

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand and East Uttar Pradesh.



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IMPACT EXPECTED & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

Isolated **very heavy rainfall** over **West Uttar Pradesh & East Rajasthan on 22nd** September, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

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
