



All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

**Monday 05 December 2022**  
**Time of Issue: 1945 hours IST**

**(NIGHT)**

**05 Dec (Day 1): ♦ Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Haryana.

♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Thundersquall (speed reaching 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and **thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places over Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather (speed 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph)** very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Andaman Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas. **Squally winds (speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph)** very likely over Southeast Bay of Bengal & adjoining Andaman Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

**06 Dec (Day 2): ♦ Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Himachal Pradesh.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Thundersquall (speed reaching 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands

♦ **Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph** very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Andaman Sea. **Squally winds (speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph)** likely over Southeast Bay of Bengal and over Southwest & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

**07 Dec (Day 3): ♦ Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Himachal Pradesh.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places very likely over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and north coastal Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places very likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph** likely over Southeast Bay of Bengal. **Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph** over Southwest Bay of Bengal and speed reaching **40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph** likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

\* Red color warning does not mean "Red Alert" Red color warning means "Take Action".

Forecast and Warning for any day is valid from 0830 hours IST of day till 0830 hours IST of next day

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**08 Dec (Day 4):** ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places with **extremely heavy falls** at isolated places likely over north Tamilnadu & Puducherry and **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and adjoining districts of Rayalaseema.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Squally wind speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph** over Southwest Bay of Bengal and speed reaching **40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph** likely to prevail along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts coast and Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

**09 Dec (Day 5):** ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over Tamilnadu and heavy rainfall at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka, Rayalaseema and south Coastal Andhra Pradesh.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** at isolated places likely over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.


♦ **Squally wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph** over Southwest Bay of Bengal and speed reaching **40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph** likely to prevail along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts coast and Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

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**IMPACT EXPECTED & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 08<sup>th</sup> and 09<sup>th</sup> and over south coastal Andhra Pradesh & adjoining Rayalaseema on 08<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.

### A. Impact Expected

- Localized water logging in low lying areas in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.

### B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

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
