

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## District Disaster Management Plan Samba

#### 1. Background

#### \*PROFILE OF DISTRICT SAMBA

It is said that Samba was a principality established somewhere in 1400 A.D As per folklore Malh Dev, the younger son of Rai sindhu of Lakhanpur was the founder of Samba Principality,who married into the family of Ghotar of local tribesman. After his marriage he stayed at Samba and made himself the master of the tract with samba as its capital. Samba ultimately came under the supremacy of Jammu, during the period of Hari Dev, in 1816 A.D in 1864 A.D, it became an integral part of the J&K state.

Newly created administrative units in the state vide Govt, order no, 1345-GAD of 2006 dated 27,10.2006 among other district, district Samba came into operation by virtue of the aforesaid government order, which comprises 382 villages as per the notification issued by the Govt. under SRO No.185 Dted 22<sup>nd</sup> of May 2007 These villages have been organized into 55 Patwar Halquas and 99 Panchyats.Out of 382 villages have been detached from Tehsil Hiranagar of District Kathua and one village from Tehsil Majalta of District Udhampur. Besides, four urban towns viz, Samba, Vijaypur, Ramgarh, and Bari Brahmna are also the part of this district.

#### \*LOCATION OF CLIMATE & GEOGRAPHY

Samba town is situated on range of Shivalik hills alongside the National Highway 1-A on the bank river Basantar at a distance of forty Kms from Jammu city. Tehsil Samba is bounded by District Udhampur in the North, District Kathua in the East, Tehsils Jammu and Bishnah of District Jammu in the West, while on the southern side it has International Border with Pakistan. About two third of the area of Tehsil Samba is Kandi & rain fed. The area on southern side downside the National highway is irrigated through Ravi Tawi Irrigation canal network and contributing towards major cereals crop and vegetables Cultivation as special focus has been assigned by the govt. of India, Ministry of water resources through Command Area Development Department.

A modern industrial complex is established on the bank of river Basantar of Samba Named as industrial Growth Centre. A number of small and medium industrial units have been established and have provided job Opportunities not only to the educated unemployed youths, but also to the labourers , skilled, and un-skilled by stating their own ventures in the private sector.

To protect the traditional art of the area, the Government has established a Handloom Development Project by SICOP at Samba and is providing employment opportunities to a large number of traditional weavers of Samba town and they are earning their livelihood by way of weaving of clothes for the project. Samba is also famous in traditional Calico Printing, where local made dyes are used for printing locally weaved cotton fabric.

Samba district has three religious tourism spots viz Mansar, Purmandal and Utterbani. The brief of which is discussed as under:--

\*Mansar Lake is situated on the Samba Udhampur Road at a distance of twenty two KMs From Samba. The Mansar Lake is Surronded by small hills with different Hindu God and Goddesses Temples and also attracts a large number of tourists as well as religious pilgrims in the area .A tourist complex comprising five tourist huts and room situated on the bank of the Lake provides accommodation to the tourist/visitors. The state government has also established development authority known as Surinsar – Mansar Development Authority.

\*Purmandal is a religious place situated at a distance of thirty nine Kms from Jammu and also connected with Samba Purmandal – Utterbani – Vijaypur Road. Purmandal is knownas"Chotta Kashi" having old Shiva temples which has significant religious importance and surrounded by the Shivalik Hills that posses a natural beauty and <u>Utterbehni</u> is another religious place situated on the bank of legendary Devika and is a heavy centuries old temples Located at a distance of five kms from Purmandal.

#### \*Climate

The climate of the district being sub tropical zone is hot dry in summer and cool in winter. Being in the foot hills of the mountains nights are bit cooler than that of neighbouring areas of Punjab. The temperature ranges between 6 degree Celsius and 47 degree Celsius.

#### \*Population:-

As per 2011 census, the total Population is 3, 18,898 which includes male population 169124 and 149774 female population in the district. This works out be 2.75% of the population of the state. The urban population is of 53615 and the rural population figures at 265283, souls and comes to 78.67% of the population of the district. The density of the population is 314 per sq km. The schedule caste represents 28% of the population while schedule tribes i.e Gujjar and Bakerwals represent 5% only of the total population of the district. The main stay of the population of the district is agriculture and services in defence.

#### 4) \* INTRODUCTION:-

#### Disaster:

Distaster may be described as the occurrence of a sudden or major misfortune which disrupts the basic fabric and normal function society (community) It is an event or a series of events which gives rise to causalities and/or damage or loss of Property, infrastructure essential services and means of livelihood.

#### \*Type of Disaster

There are two main types Diseaster namely Natural and man made .Based on the sources origin or relativity of disaster it can be sub divided into following types.

- \* Water and climate:- Eg, Flood, Cyclone, Drought, Tornadoes, Hailstone and cloud brust thunder and lighting.
- \* Geological:- Eg. Landslide and Mudflow, Earthquake, Volcano, Dam Failure, Mine fire.
- Chemical, Industrial and Nuclear hazards or disasters.
- \* Accidents:- Forest Fires, urban Fires, Mine Flooding, Oil spill, Major building Collapse, bomb blast, electrical accidents, air. road, air, road accident.
- \* Boat Capsizing, Village fire.

Our main vision and aim regarding the accomplishment of this is full proof communication and coordination authentic and accurate database, documents and rehearsed to be activated in the shortest possible time with minimum simple orders and procedures ensuring active participation by Government, volunteers, Community at all levels, making optimum utilization of men, material and resources leaving no gaps and no overlaps to prevent the loss of property ensuring fastest restoration of the situation and also sustenance of achievements of the programme even after programme duration.

#### \*Goal:-

Sustainable reduction in Disaster risks and recovery in all nooks and corners of Samba districts with active ,participation of local Government and community.

#### \*RATIONALE:-

Disaster Risk Management Programme is a huge programme, which will strengthen all institutions at all levels to minimize the loss of life and property during any disaster in the shortest possible time through optimum preparedness, mitigation and response plan. Hence, the rationale of an affective and realistic District Risk Management Plan was felt. This comprehensive Disaster Risk Management Plan will strengthen the efforts of the

District Administration. This plan was prepared and complied by the District Disaster Management Committee and its is responsible for renewing the plan once in every two years.

#### 5)\*OBJECTIVES:-

- 1. To provide effective supports and resources to the individual and groups during Disaster.
- 2. To prevent loss of human lives and property- preparedness, Prevention and Mitigation of Disasters.
- 3. Development covering in addressing and mitigation in Disaster Management.
- 4. To provide a systematic organized, flexible and effective approach in dealing with any calamity- natural of manmade.
- 5. To disseminate factual information in an accurate and tactful manner, while maintaining necessary confidentiality.
- 6. To give the best possible assistance and assurance while dealing with individual in disaster and eliciting the least possible disruption to the normal life process.
- 7. Ensuring optimum and active participation of Government, Community, Volunteers, and Voluntary organizations at all levels making optimal utilization of human and material resources.
- 8. To facilitate mitigation at all level.

#### 7)\* RISK MAPPING OF DISTRICT SAMBA REGARDING FLOODS

In the jurisdiction of District Samba under this Division there are two major rivers namely Basantar and Devak in addition to numerous local Nallahas spreading throughout the district. These water bodies have large catchments which start from lower ranges of Himalayas. These Rivers and Nallahas are calm during most of the time but become furious during Monsoons/ Rainy causes due to rains and subsequent heavy discharge. The floods causes erosion of land of villagers, loss to property of people and the public infrastructure in general. The most vulnerable areas are:-

#### Brief Note on Flood Control problem under the jurisdiction of Flood Control Division, Samba (District Samba)

In the jurisdiction of this Division, two major river namely River Basanter and River Devak flow in addition to numerous local nallahs spreading throughout the district. These water bodies have large catchment which starts from lower ranges of Himalays. These Rivers and nallhas are calm during most of time but become ferocious during monsoons/rainy season due to rains and subsequent heavy discharge. The floods cause erosion of the land of the villagers and loss to the property of the people. The public property may also get damaged.

Flood Control Deportment has constructed some protection works on down stream and up stream side of the National Highway in these rivers and nallahs by way of construction of earthen embankments, crate revetments, spurs and crate bars as per the availability of funds/ plan allocation. Still much need to be done.

According to the present situation the reaches of danger have been located on these nallahs/rives, the list of which is enclosed as Annexure 'A'. This office shall be closely watching these rives/nallahs during the monsoon period i.e. **01-07-2015 to 30-09-2015** and has framed an action plan for the purpose, which is as under:-

A Flood Sub- Committee with Executive Engineer Flood Control Division Samba as Member Secretary and Officers from other departments as Members shall be working in close co- ordination and apprising the higher authorities of flood situation from time to time. The Sub Committee shall operate from office of the Executive Engineer F.C. Div.Samba with Telephone No. **01923-243248** and W.L.L. No. **219306.** A list of members of Flood Sub Committee Samba is enclosed as per Annexure 'B'

The Field staff of Flood Control Div. Samba shall be employed on different Rivers/Nallahs round the clock to keep a close watch on the situation in the field and report/solve the problem arising from Flood fury, if any in close co-ordination with Flood Sub committee. The Duty Chart W.e.f. **01-07-2014 to 30-09-2014** is enclosed as Annexure 'C'.

They shall be also responsible for communicating Gauge/ Discharge in the Rivers to Control Room to be set up at Samba. This Control Room shall be established in the office of Executive Engineer Flood Control Division Samba which shall be manned by the staff of Flood Control Division Samba. This Control Room shall operate round the clock with Telephone No. **01923-243248** & W.L.L. No. **219306**. The purpose of this Control Room is to register complaints of people regarding Flood fury if any and further communicate the same to field agencies and high ups. The Duty Charts shall be issued in due time and copies of same supplied to all concerned.

Agenda for Anti Flood Programme meeting scheduled to be held in the Conference Hall of District Administrative Complex, Samba under the Chairmanship of Distt.

Development Commissioner, Samba (Chairman, District Flood Committee District Samba.) on 16-06-2014 at 10.00 A.M

#### 1. Action to be taken by Flood Control Division Samba:-

- (i) Setting up of Control Room in the office of Flood Control Division Samba which shall work round the clock w.e.f **01-07-2014 to 30-09-2014** with telephone No. 01923-243248 and W.L.L.No: 219306 The Tech. Officer to Executive Engineer, Flood Control Division Samba shall be the over all in charge of Control Room.
- (ii) Deployment of staff at different sites as per Duty Chart from 01-07-2014 to 30-09-2014
- (iii) To maintain adequate stock of empty cement bags, Knitted crates and B.A. wire in Divisional stores, so that same can be used as per requirement.
- (iv) To arrange the required funds for Anti Flood Measures

#### 2. Action to be taken by Revenue Authorities:-

- (i) To Issue timely flood warnings to the population of Flood affected areas and Arrangement of their evacuation to safer places.
- (ii) To ensure arrangement of sufficient stock of essential commodities like rice, wheat, sugar, kerosene/ L.P.G and other items
- (iii) To arrange tents for the People effected during the Floods

#### 3. Action to be taken by police authorities:-

- (i) To keep wireless facilities available during flood season and maintaining law and order problem arising due to floods, if any.
- (ii) To help Flood Control Department by supplying manpower if required in case of any eventuality.
- (iii) To maintain traffic on highway and other roads during water logging if any.

#### 4. Action to be taken by Army authorities (168 Inf. Brigade C/O 56 A.P.O)

To help the civilian departments by supplying men and machinery in case of any eventuality arising due to floods. These shall be made available on the request of District Administration, Samba and the army authorities are also requested to keep ready the following items in case of emergency to the civil authorities as & when required:-

(i) Tents = 50 Nos. (ii) Lanterns = 30 Nos. (iii) Petromaxs = 10 Nos.

(iv) Flash Lights and heavy duty torches. = As per Requirement

(v) Ropes required for evacuation = -do-

(vi) Boats and helicopters whenever requisitioned for Evacuation of peoples = -do

(vii) Man power for evacuation of peoples = 100 Nos

(viii) Dozer for diversion of flow of flood water centrally in the river. = 1 Nos.

5. Action to be taken by Municipal Committee Samba/Vijaypur/Ramgarh/ Bari-Barhmna/ Executive Engineer Town Drainage Division, Jammu:-

To get local drains of Samba Town and other areas cleaned before on set of rainyseason for smooth drainage of water and thus avoid flooding of Samba Town & other areas

#### 6. Action to be taken by Medical Department Samba:-

To keep sufficient stock of following medicines during Monsoon Season **2014** for tackling any eventuality arising due to floods:

- i) Anti Snake bite and Anti cholera Vaccine.
- ii) First AID.
- iii) Deployment of Ambulance(s) as and when Required.

#### 7. Action to be taken by Food and Supplies Deptt. Samba:-

To maintain sufficient stock of essential commodities during Flood Season.

#### 8. Action to be taken by Mech. Irri. const. Div. Jammu.

To ensure installation of 1 No. Dewatering Pump in working condition at Harijan Basti Samba with 1 No. Dewatering Pump in working condition as standby for the purpose. In addition to this, the department shall keep two Nos. Dewatering Pumps ready in working condition for use in case of emergency arising during Flood Season at various locations as per requirement. To ensure supply of knitted crates as per requirement and as per situation arising out of floods if any on request of Executive Engineer, Flood Control Division Samba, in time.

#### 9. Transport:-

Deputy Director, Garages shall ensure deployment of additional transport facility i.e Light Motor Vehicles on short notice on the request of Executive Engineer Flood Control Division Samba. The P.O.L. Charge shall be borne by the office of Executive Engineer Flood Control Division Samba.

#### 10. Action to be taken by Telephone Department :-

To ensure proper functioning of the telephone No. **01923-243248 and W.L.L.No.219306** during Monsoon Season installed in Control Room of Flood Control Division Samba. In addition to this, keep telephone of all other departments in working order.

#### 11. Action to be taken By the P.H.E Department.

To supply Super chlorinated water during the Monsoon Season and to provide safe drinking water through Water Tankers after evacuation of affected people to the safer places

#### 12. Action to be taken by the Sister Engg. Departments.

Executive Engineer P.H.E Div. Samba, Ex. Engineer RCC Div-ii L/C Hiranagar, Executive Engineer R&B Div. Samba, shall render helping hand to Executive Engineer Flood Control Division Samba (Member Secretary, Flood Control Committee Distt. Samba) in case of any eventuality arising due to heavy rains and subsequent floods in form of manpower and machinery on request.

#### 13. Action to be taken by Education Department:-

Education Department shall ensure providing of temporary accommodation in Schools for the people to be shifted to safer areas due to flood threat or flood problem if the need arises.

#### 14. Action to be taken by Electric Department:

Electric Department shall keep arrangements for lighting, ready for its use as per need.

The Deputy Commissioner (Chairman) has the information with him relating to the official manpower available with him, of which, he would use of in case of emergency at all levels and list of such able and healthy officers/ officials has been made so that they can be called and check up on already assigned duties and in case they are to be sent for some kind of training arrangements shall be made. The matter of regular trainings shall be taken up with the Commandant Army, CRPF of Samba district with whom discussions have been made. Such a mechanism will be followed at all levels i.e Tehsil level.

The Additional Commissioner Development, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Additional District Magistrates at Headquarters shall assist the Deputy Commissioner (Chairman) in all such functions and will ensure specific areas oriented duties as assigned to them.

#### 9);- Resource of evacuation

#### Role and Responsible of District OfficersSr. Superintendent of police:-

The Sr. Superintendent of Police is having the information with him relating to his manpower available at each level, so that in case of need even those persons who are on leave can be called and put on duty. His services are needed to maintain law and order and put on duty, His Services are needed to maintain law and order and it is also required that he keeps watch on anti-social elements rumor- mongers and those elements who want to take advantage of the situations. Such a list/information should be provided to the

chairman (DC). At present, the District Police has strength of about 850 personal. More Personal Can be made available in due course of time.

- An officer to be appointed as Nodal officer on his behalf.
- Over all traffic management and patrolling of all highway and other access roads to disaster sites.
- Identification of anti social elements.
- Provision of security in Transit camps / relief camps/ feeding centers/ cattle camps / cooperative food stores centers.
- All staff informed about the disaster, likely damages and effected.

#### Superintending Engineer (PWD):-

Restoration of Communication / Transportation is of utmost importance in such an evening an Superintending (PWD) is required to be well equipped with emergency plan in the event of disaster taking place. He should have complete information with regarded the Man power, Machinery and material at all place in the district, at his disposal and priority shall be given to re-open the blocked/closed roads and to provide the manpower in case of exigency such list of information be also provided to the chairman,

- Communication establishment with District/Block office/Control rooms and departmental offices with in the Division.
- Inspection and emergency repair for Roads/ Bridge / under water Inspection piers concrete and steel work.
- Emergency Inspection by mechanical engineer of all plans and equipments.
- Route strategy for evacuation and relief marked.
- Community assistance mobilized for road clearing.
- All start informed about the disaster, likely damages and effects.
- <u>PWD</u> Skilled manpower = 23 Gang Coolie
- Vehicle for Rescue = Nil.

- Cranes = Not available with PWD Samba.
- Note;- PWD is advised to make Bunkers near border areas to provide temporary shelters during emergencies (as per the instructions given by the worthy Dy. Commissioner in the meeting)

#### **HEALTH DEPARTMENT (CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER)**

Similarly, the chief Medical officer submitted a list of officers/officials of his department working at different locations. Whenever situation arises, he will be position to dispatch reasonable number of doctors, Para-medical staff, medicines and other equipment to the site of occurrence of disasters whether it is earthquake or any natural calamity e.g flood. Cloudburst, drought etc. he is further directed .He should have sufficient medicines in stock which should be available all the time so that he has not to rush to market for purchase Lifesaving drugs should be utilized and replenished on and on.

- In hours of emergency medical team to ensure that adequate staff available at all tim to handle emergency causalities.
- Providing assistance of district authorities for taking action against hoarders black market and those found manipulating relief materials.
- Coordination with Military services personal in the area being carried out under relief operation.
- Providing assistance to the community in organized emergency transport or injured.

#### **Current Status of Disaster Risk, Reduction Plans and Drills**

- All the staff members are being trained regarding their roles and responsibilities during any such disaster.
- Mock drills are being planned and carried out.

#### Additional Deputy Commissioner/ Additional District Magistrates.

At the time of occurrence of any natural calamities in the District, the Additional Deputy Commissioner . Additional District Magistrate will assist the Deputy Commissioner in the discharge of his duties in the maintenance of law and order and they shall also coordinate rescue/relief measures with various departments/bodies.In the absence of Deputy Commissioner (Chairman) the ADC/ADM shall automatically perform all such functions. No vacuums should occur at any time.

#### \*Superintending Engineer Hydraulic (I&FC)

The superintending Engineer Hydraulic (I&FC) will ensure the supply of drinking water as required to maintain/restore the drinking water supply. Moreover, he has the detail of manpower and material available in the district at difference locations which will be pressed in to the action with in the shortest possible notice. Such a list/information should be also provided to the chairman.

#### ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, CA&PD SAMBA.

During disaster, the supply of essential commodities has to be ensured The AD CA&PD has information and requisite stocks of food grains available in different / godowns /supply outlets of the district and it has been ensured that whenever required they will be in a position to provide essential food stuff and other essential commodities at a short notice without delay. As for as Samba district is concerned any kind of supply required in interior of district can be provided with in 3 to 4 hour. So arrangement have been made in such away that this mechanism works.

- Keeping list of whole sale traders of local market.
- List of storage agents with quantity of monthly allotments and uptake.
- List of petrol pumps dealers.

The executive officer municipal Committee Samba / Ramgarh / Bari Barhmana / Vijaypur have been directed to submit a detail plan for disaster preparedness/ Prevention / Mitigation for the urban of Samba district.

#### \*TELECOMMUNICATION DEPARTMENT

The Telecom District Manager shall make sincere efforts to restore telecommunication services in the affected areas immediately, so that there is no communication gap and he shall put all available manpower and machinery to use for restoration of communication services without delay.

#### \*GENERAL MANAGER SRTC

The General Manager, SRTC is required to provide transportation facilities for the evacuation purpose and shall have a Contingent plan with respect have been District mentioning the availability of buses, cranes etc along with locations.

## \*Forest Department

#### **CONSERVATION OF FORESTS**

The conservators of forest is required to have all the information with him in relation to manpower timber and fuel wood in different locations of the district and will also coordinate with the forest corporation in the supply of timber and fuel wood in case required at any of the places of occurrences of disaster in the District.

- Communication established with District/ Block officer rooms and department officers within the division.
- Any officer to be appointed as Nodel Officer.
- Information provided about the diseases and likely damages to crop and plantation.
- Surveillance of pests and disease being carried out.
- Established of public information centers requirement for salvages or assesses damage.
- Identification of different areas to be affected by different hazards.
- Listing of Irrigation sources with status.
- All staff information about the disaster, likely damages and effects.

#### \*ANIMAL & SHEEP HUSBANDRY DEPARTMENT

During disaster the Animal and sheep husbandry department required to perform the following functions:-

Department required to perform the following functions:-

- Communication establishment with District / Block Office/ control rooms and department officers with the division.
- An officer to be appointed as nodal officer.
- Listing of animal population with category Reflected in District profile.
- Stock pilling of emergency medicines and medical equipments.
- Arrangement of anesthetic drugs/ vehicles for transport of injured animals.
- Identification of places for opening of operational sites. (List of school building in enclosed for evacuation purpose at B)
- Stock pilling of fodder water and animals feed.
- All staff informed about the disaster likely damages and effects.
- Control rooms set up/ assignment of control room.
- Pre-Positioning of staffs for site operation centers.
- Arrangement of alternative communication with district control Room.
- Ensuring Convergence with villages committee.

#### \*EDUCATION DEPARTMENT;-

#### **CHIEF EDUCATION OFFICER**

In case of Disaster the Chief Education Officer shall appoint a Nodal officer along with sufficient staff/NC volunteers for evacuating the people from disaster area to identified school building and have a close liaison with District Administration. He should have the information with him relating to his manpower available at each level, so that in case of need even those person who are on leaves can be called & put on duty. Some School building May also identified with sufficient grounds for cattle camps.

#### \*MILITARY AND PARA MILITARY FORCES.

The Commandant, Home Guards, Commandant Army, Commandant CRPF, Commandant GREF and five officer shall work in close coordination with the District Administration and shall have access to all the available manpower, machinery and material at their respective disposal They are required to draw contingent plan with all available resources at their command and shall also apprise the Chairman of such information. This organization shall also be responsible for their protection of vital installation and maintain the supply lines.

In the above mentioned paras the functioning of the District Officer/ District Disaster Management Committee has been enumerated in detail, Similar kind of arrangement shall be made at the lower levels mentioned below.

- 1. Tehsil level.
- 2. Sub. Tehsil Level

For Example, Suppose an incident of disaster occurs at district Headquarter and there is tremendous and God Forbids, If Nobody Survives and Vacuum is created during such times the committees Formed at sub divisional / Tehsil/ Sub- Tehsil level will immediate rush with necessary manpower and material to render assistance in respect of rescue, relief and rehabitation. If such a situation arises at sub-Divisional Headquarter then the committees formed at Tehsil/ Sub-Tehsil/ Block levelshall function and of course committee at District Headquarter will awing.

As the incident of earthquake is of different nature and it affect both men and property it also requires personnel, specifically trained to rescue people and extend necessary relief. It is essential to impart training to a sizeable number of able bodies official and officer working in the different department of the district, who in case of dire need can be called upon called to go to sire of disaster and render assistance to the District Administration. The Civil defense (DSP) Commandant CRPF has assured that he can arrange to impart training to a group of at least 15- 20 persons at a time and the process will continue till reasonable number of officials/ officers is trained. The minimum time for training is days.

\*Sirens:-Two Sirens are provided to this town and are being tested regularly, one siren is installed at the Police Station building Samba and another Siren is installed at the MES Building Maheshwar, Samba. Both the Siren is required one at District Administrative Complex and another at Railway Station building, Samba.

*Note*:-More number of sirens should be installed at Ghagwal, Vijaypur, Ramgarh, Mansar, Bari-Brahmana etc. in order to give indication for the coming disaster.

\*. General Warning to Public:- In the event of war, in the case of surprise attack, a general call-up to activate all Civil Defence measures will be issued by the fastest means including a general broadcast from RCDCC Jammu and Public will be informed by sounding of Sirens.

a) Air Raid Message = 'Yellow'

The object of keeping this message confidential is to minimize public alarm. It is received by a limited number of officials on special warning such a Headquarters of Civil Defence Organization, Police, Fire Brigade, Important Factories, Public Utility concern and Railways.

b) Air Raid Message ='Red'

<u>Action Warning</u>:-This message is received by those on the action warning list of threatened towns. The message is passed by telephone to authorities on the action warning list some of whom will be responsible for sounding the Air Raid Warning signals. The warning is made known to public by Sirens. The actual signal is of the two minutes duration.

c) Air Raid Message = 'Green'.

Raiders Passed:- This message means that raiding Aircraft have left the towns warned or no longer appear to threaten those towns. The text of this message is "Air Raid Message-Green" and is conveyed to all recipients of Action warning. This message is passed by telephone to authorities on the action warning list some of whom will sound the Raiders passed signal. This signal is issued to public by sounding of Sirens for duration of two minutes at a steady pitch. The term all clear should not be used for this signal.

d) Air Raid message = 'White'

<u>Cancel Caution</u>:-This means the preliminary threat has passed. The text of this message is 'Air Raid Message-White'. This message is received the preliminary caution. On receipt of this normalcy is resumed.

<u>CORPSE DISPOSAL SERVICE</u>:-In case of natural calamities, all Raids the disposal of dead bodies become a great problem especially if the disaster is on the large scale. The dead bodies have to be disposed off before they start decomposing. Late disposal of the dead bodies not only dangerous the public health of the community but also effects the morale of the people, so it is essential for organizing the corpse disposal squad which is headed by the Health officer Town Area Committies of district Samba including Samba, Vijaypur, Ghagwal, Ramgarh and Bari-Brahmana and trustees of Cat-II CD Samba.

<u>Disposal of Un-Exploded Bomb</u>:-It is the duty of Civil Defence Wardens/Volunteers to inform the Civil Defence authorities / Police about the persons as any un-exploded bomb in their area and keep keen eye watch / stop all type of movement near the un-exploded bomb. Accordingly the Civil Defence authority or Police will call the bomb disposal party to defuse the un-exploded bomb. The awareness in this regard has already given to the Civil defence wardens / Civil Defence Volunteers. The Reconnaissance party has been organized consisting of the following members from the CD Wardens and Volunteers.

The Recee party, Rescue party & First Aid party was confined to only Samba but now it is increased in the whole District as directed by Dy. Commissioner Samba List of Warden Posts (Seven Numbers)

<u>Action on receipt of General Warning:</u>-The Civil Defence Wardens / Volunteers will make the people of the area aware about the Air Raid shelters. Moreover after sounding Sirens the following action is required:-

#### a) Complete black-out.

<u>Depot Service</u>:- The main Depot Service has been identified at DC office Samba and is extended upto different sub branches including Govt. Hr. Sec. Schools, Communities halls etc. (including Samba, Vijaypur ,Ramgarh, Ghagwal and Bari-Brahmana area) All the services will operate from the above Depot during Air raids and natural calamities. The Civil Defence Warden is the Head of the service in their own locality

\*Welfare Service:-The primary function of welfare service is to assist people in deed after an enemy attack to minimize the sufferings of the community by providing adequate information to the relatives of missing persons and by providing shelter, food and clothing etc. to effected persons. The officer from welfare department will be the officer commanding of welfare officer, CD Warden and CD Volunteer will also assist the welfare officer. The following Rest Centres have earmarked for providing shelters:-

- 1. SIDCO Industries Samba/Bari Brahmana.
- 2. Govt. Girls Hr. Secondary School Samba.
- 3. Govt. Boys Hr. Secondary School Samba.
- 4. Govt Degree College Samba.
- 5. Govt. Hr.Sec, School Ramgarh, Vijaypur, Ghagwal, and Bari-brahmana

#### \*Duties of Welfare Service:-

- 1. Supply of information regarding missing relatives, dead, nature of facilities and assistance available for effected people and enrolment in civil Defence service.
- 2. Provision of rest centre, where people whose homes are destroyed by air raids for temporary shelter, food and clothing.
- 3. Dispersal of population from the congested areas to less vulnerable areas and making suitable arrangements for the evacuees during transit and at the destination.

\*Salvage Organization:- During any disaster( Man made or natural) valuable may get buried in damaged buildings and the owner may not be able to get it due to causalities or run away due to fear. The arrangements for salvaged property should include:-

- a) For custody of property/valuable by an appropriate officer who may be called Custodian.
- b) Protection of property against exposure to rains etc.
- c) Maintenance of proper accounts.

<u>Transport Service</u>:-The transport service will be provided by the State Road Transport Corporation /local Mini Bus Union and Civil Defence authorities. The duties of transport services are:-

- a) To provide sufficient transport and maintain the vehicles in road worthy Condition.
- b) To procure vehicles for Civil Defence by hire requisition and voluntary offer.
- c) To provide trained drivers.
- d) To issue fuel and lubricants and ensure economy in their use.
- e) To make arrangements for quick repairs and servicing of vehicles.

#### \*Causality Service:-

The responsibility lies with CMO to Co-ordinate with Civil Defence authorities Samba and to nominate a Medical officer. He will provide staff / Ambulances and medical equipment to the first aid post at Ghagwal, Vijaypur, Ramgarh, Bari-Brahmana and Samba. Medical First responder also provides help during causalities.

#### \*Fire Fighting:-

In Samba District, there are 20 house of fire fighting i.eGhagwal, Vijaypur, Ramgarh, Bari-Brahmana and Samba. Each of four persons have been constituted of one party per 16000 of the population from the trainees Civil Defence Volunteers of Samba. The District Fire officer Samba will be the incharge of House fire parties.

#### Observation of Black / Dim Out:-

Lighting restrictions are a important features of precautionary measures to be taken as a form of security against Air Attact. The restriction imposes general darkness in the vulnerable area and there is an obligation on controlling lights. The awareness has already been given to the Civil Defence Wardens/Civil Defence Volunteers in this regard of Cat-II Town, Samba.

### • <u>Lighting Restrictions</u>:-

Lighting restrictions are important features of precautionary measures to be taken for the safety of people against Border firing . In Samba , Ramgarh, Ghagwal,and Baribrahmana the people have been educated through Civil Defence Wardens / Volunteers regarding lighting restrictions during Air Raids.

#### • Camouflage and Associate Aspects:-

In Samba and Bari-Brahmana all the industries, Gas plants, Oil Depots and other vital installations have been camouflaged for the safety of these installations to maintain the continuity of production after AIR Raids/Fireing.

#### • Public Health / Emergency Sanitation:-

To maintain the standard of public health and sanitation during ward is of great importance. If steps are not taken well in time for proper sanitation , there is very apprehension of out break of epidemic resulting a large scale deaths which effect on the

moral of the people and will also hamper the Civil Defence Work, for the basic responsibilities the following points should be planned:-

- b. Regulation of sanitation in shelters and emergency camps.
- c. Adequate food inspection during emergency of kitchen and canteen.
- d. Maintenance / restoration of sanitation standard in the disposal and savage and solid wastage and diminution of water supply.
- e. Prevention of epidemic by mass inoculation.
- .\* <u>Maintenance of Essential Services</u>:-The following essential services are existing in Cat-II Civil Defence town Samba:
  - a. Health department.
  - b. Electric department.
  - c. PHE department.
  - d. Fire station.
  - e. Chief Warden.

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### 10) \* Mitigation Activities planning:-

The long term of measure would be according to the disasters and need planned. In frequent fire accident, fire services Station are to be set up, periodic checking, training the people etc, In case of flood, dams, water storage structure, desalting, bank protection and watershed management to be followed. Environment degradation caused could be addressed by Watershed management principles. Biomass Production wick be another Long term strategy, Planting trees, shrubs and promoting pasture to be taken in hand.

The disaster could be mitigated by putting structural solution like dams, embankments stone walls, water storage pump etc. These are costly and needs one time heavy investment.

Various activities taken up as long term measure for earth quake disaster mitigation may include.

- ➤ Re farming the building codes, guidelines, manuals and by laws and their proper implementation. Stricter legislation for highly seismic areas, in the regard.
- ➤ In high risk areas, all building should incorporate earthquake resistant features.
- ➤ Public utilities like water supply system communication network, electricity lines, etc must alternative arrangement for same must be developed.
- ➤ Community buildings and building used to gathering of large number of persons like school, dharamshalls, hospitals, prayer halls etc, must be made earthquake resistant in seismic zones of moderate to high intensities.
- ➤ Technical training in polytechnics and schools to includes disaster related topics.

\*Medium term Measure:- The Medium term measure for earthquake disaster mitigation may be listed as follow.

- ➤ Retrofitting of the week structures in highly seismic zones.
- ➤ Preparation of literature in local language with do,s and don't for the building constructions.
- ➤ Getting community involved in the process of disaster mitigation by providing them proper education and awareness.
- > Supporting local technical institutions/ colleges/ school to conduct restart and to organize exhibition etc for public awareness.
- ➤ Networking of local NGOs working in the area disaster management. Post disaster preventing measures.

#### \*Short Term Measure:-

When the disaster are inevitable the only way is to mitigate its impact which could fall under the short term measure like immediate relief, reducing the response time to avert any loss, the basic needs of the vunerable and affected people to be given to those who have lost their properties, movables, those minimum essential items to be supplied even smaller loans at a concessional rates for long/ short term loan etc.

The urgent measure to be undertaken in the aftermath of a damaging earthquake will include the following.

➤ Maintenance of law and order, prevention of trespassing looting etc.

## \*Evacuation of people:-

- > Recovery of dead bodies and their disposal.
- > Medical care for injured.
- Supply of food drinking water.
- ➤ Temporary shelters like tents, metal sheds etc.
- ➤ Restoring lines of communication and information.
- Restoring transport routes.
- Quick assessment of damage and demarcation of damaged areas according to grade of damage.
- ➤ Cordoning off soberly damaged structures that are liable to collapse during aftershocks.

#### \*The following preparedness actions will be usefull.

- ➤ Community should be trained in search, rescue and relief at the time of disaster in high areas.
- ➤ An extensive programme of mass drills may be very helpful in high risk areas for earthquake damage reduction.
- ➤ Local NGOs should be trained and their capacity and capabilities should be strengthen.
- ➤ Introduction earthquake disaster safety do's and don't and drills in schools.
- > To organize training to fiels personnel surveys,(a) for urgent relief, (b) for repair, reconstruction and retrofitting purposes.
  - An effort needs to be made in an emergency phase to involve the affected people to the maximum extent do as to create a feeling of self reliance They need to be as quickly as possible so that the period of relief is minimized.

Detailed survey of building is required for assessment of damage as decision regarding, reconstruction and strengthening or demolition.

- ➤ Repair, reconstruction and seismic strengthening of demolition.
- > Selection of site for new settlements, If required.
- ➤ Review of the existing seismic zoning maps and risk maps.
- > Training of personal, engineers, architects, builders and masons.

### 11) Preparedness activities :-

Coupled with appropriate public awareness building for relief & rescue, use of Geographical Information System (GIS), according to the hazards identified and vulnerability analyzed, zone to be done disaster wise according to its occurrence Example: around the industrial areas, flood prone areas accident prone areas, landslide prone areas etc. the Geographical Information system will be able to locate the vulnerable areas and also help in identifying areas where water table is available for digging wells and bore wells etc. GIS is a good tool in handling disasters. Public awareness creation is the most effective way in handing disasters. There should be mock drill exercise for evacuation in industrial disaster. Public awareness building in terms of seismic zones to follow the building codes will be effective. In the disaster management plan there should be components for public awareness creation. Various measure of risk reduction can be classified in terms of preparedness, mitigation and prevention in the pre-earthquake phase. These are immediate rescue and relief measure including temporary sheltering from just after an earthquake event. These can neither be prevented nor predict in terms of their magnitude, place and time of occurrence.

There fore the most effective measure of risk reduction are pre- disaster mitigation preparedness and preventive measure for reducing the vulnerability of the build environment and expeditious effective resue and relief actions immediately after the occurrence of the earthquake. The measure can be diverted into long term medium term five year and short term to be taken up immediately in high risk areas. It may be started at this juncture earthquake don't kill people buildings too. Therefore most importantly reduction of vulnerability building through a post earthquake response plan' Including training of the concerned personal in various task is considered essential for immediate and effective response after an earthquake occurrences. The major action points are highlighted in the following table.

# 12)\* Emergency Response planning:-

### **Response Mechanisn**

On receipt of warning of the disaster, part of the immediate response is to warm the people. In the case of floods and cyclones, enough early warning time is normally available for this purpose. Existing procedures lay down dissemination procedure on the part of the government agency concerned through print and electronic media as well as informing the authorities concerned. It is secondary to reach all the people in the likely affected areas that is responsibility of the District Administration especially to those people who have no access to mass media modes. This could be by beat of drums, sounding of sirens village gongs, if any or by words of mouth. Some local means need to be evolved and be kept in place to ensure that people come to know of the impending calamity and to take in place to ensure that people come to know of the impending calamity and to take suitable follow up action to save their lives and belonging for the duration of the calamity. Generally safe places are the pacca buildings i.e school panchayatghars and other public and identified private buildings. It is essential to provide food. Safe drinking water, hygene and sanitation facilities in these areas. Evacuation drill must be known to the population at large. Post flood management programme must ensure the following points.

- Normal water supply in the affected areas either by arranged tankers or fire tenders.
- ➤ Repair of the power, telephone and sewerage lines or priority basis so that normalcy is restored.
- ➤ Proper arrangement for the supply of food, shelter and clothing to the marooned people.
- ➤ Ensuring adequate supply of POL and kerosene oil and keeping the supply lines moving.
- ➤ Constitution of survey team to assess the loss compensation to be given to the affected population.
- ➤ Assistance for repair/ rebuilding of private properties.
- Desilting and dewatering of the inundated areas.
- ➤ Taking up appropriate measure according to Contingency plan for the agriculture sector.

#### 13)\* DISTRICT CONTIGENCY PLAN ACTION POINTS.

#### Pre-flood arrangement

- ➤ Covering a meeting of District level committee of disaster management.
- ➤ Functioning of the Control Rooms.

- ➤ Closure of past breaches in river and guarding of weak points.
- ➤ Rain recording and submission of rainfall reports.
- > Communication of guage reading and preparation of maps and charts.
- ➤ Dissemination of weather reports and flood bulleting issued by the meteorological Centers, Central water Commission and flood Forecasting organization.
- Deployment of boats at strategic points.
- Arrangement for keeping telephone and telegraph lines in order.
- Storage of food on interior, vulnerable strategic and key areas.
- ➤ Arrangement of dry foodstuff and other necessities of life.
- ➤ Arrangement for keeping the drainage system desilted and properly maintained.
- > Agriculture measure.
- > Health measure.
- Veterinary measure
- > Selection of food relief work.
- > Advance arrangement for army assistance.
- > Training in flood relief work.
- Organization of relief parties.
- ➤ Other precautionary measure and.
- ➤ Alternative drinking water supply arrangements.

#### Arrangement during and after floods.

- Organizing shelter for the people in distress.
- ➤ If relief measure are considered inadequate Army assistance should be requisitioned.
- ➤ Relief measure by non official and voluntary organization may be enlisted as far as possible.
- Organize relief camps.
- ➤ Provision of basic amenities like water, sanitation and public health care and arrangements of cooked food in relief camps.
- ➤ Making necessary arrangement for air dropping of food packet in the marooned village through helicopter.
- ➤ Organizing enough relief parties to the rescue of the marooned people.
- Starting effective functional Control Room.

The following preparatory steps will be taken up for keeping marooned people.

- i. Shift one more phone line to the C.R
- ii. Keep radio with the new batteries ready.
- iii. Hire one generator set.

- iv. Stock two barriers of kerosene and petrol for running the generator set.
- v. Charge the batteries of VHF set (If installed)
- vi. Charge the battery in inventor.
- vii. In case of cyclone earthquake or any hazardous disaster, arrange for six extra batteries.
- viii. Charge the satellite phone and test it.
- ix. Keep two numbers of four wheels ready.
- x. Ensure availability of the list of identified shelters- with route chart list of NGO, Volunteers, NCC, NSS other youth Volunteers.
- xi. Alert all field officers: NH, PHE, Muncipality, MLA, MPs, Station Director AIR, warning should be informed in the following manner DPRO should inform the media.
- a. Call up all the officers and ensure that they remain in the Headquarters until the situation is normalized
- b. Prepare a logbook for recording chronological sequence of events time to time.
- c. Check the availability of (Rice ,Dal,Atta) and kerosene at block headquarters with storage agents and other inaccessible pockets. BDOs shall contact all agent .they personally visit the godowns and verify the stocks. The storage agents shall remain present at the store round the clock .BDOs shall immediately depute the officer to the place where the storage godowns and located .
- d. The deputy director of supply should be informed to remain alert for procurement of dry food/essential commodities on short notice.
- e. Direct the private stockiest / whole whole seller and FCI to remain open on all days , including Sundays and holidays till the situation is normalized .
- f. Place requisition to the RTO for deployment of vehicles.
- g. Start movement of food stock with the help of A.D , CA&PD from district HQs to block HQs .
- h. Regulate the sale and supply of POL
- i. Get sandbags and mud begs from PWD division
- HEALTH SECTOR- make a rapid assessment of the following
- > check up the stock of medicines, bleaching powder and halogen tablets . if necessary, send immediate requisition of DM & HO.
- > Start movement of medicines , bleaching powder etc to PHCs & CHCs
- ➤ Ensure that medical officers are in place at the PHCs & CHCs.
- ➤ All CDPOs shall be teamed up with the medical officers of PHCs/CHCs with there vehicles and supervisors.

- \* veterinary measures- DVO shall make assessment of vaccines and fodder availability for cattle .
- i.  $\,$  air dropping zones : make a list of villages where air dropping may be need , identify the air

dropping zones.

J. Each JE of PWD and irrigation shall keep ready at least a team of 20 persons with axes and saws and also have one chain pulley system ready .

### **HPCL** (Hindustan Petrol Corporation Limited)

HPCL owns & operates 2 major refineries producing a wide variety of petroleum fuels & specialties, one in **Mumbai** (West Coast) of **6.5** Million Metric Tonnes Per Annum (MMTPA) capacity and the other in **Visakhapatnam**, (East Coast) with a capacity of **8.3** MMTPA. HPCL also owns and operates the largest Lube Refinery in the country producing Lube Base Oils of international standards, with a capacity of 428 TMT.

**Receipt:** 1) Receipt is by road (Tank truck) from LPG Bottling Plant, Bhatinda.

**Storage:** Presently total storage will be to 1500MT .The old 04above ground Bullets will be replaced with 03 Mounded Bullet with a capacity of 500 MT each.

**Delivery:** Packed cylinders are delivered in a Truck with a capacity of 300 cylinders and 450 cylinders to the market. Bulk is supplied thru Tankers.

Type of cylinders are filled are 14.2kg/19kg/35kg/5.0 Kg/47.5kg

#### 1 Location of the plant, surrounding areas & population

JAMMU LPG Plant was commissioned in the year 1986 with a total Area of 33 Acres (around 1, 36,890 Sq M). This Plant is using state of the art technology 24 Head Carousal which produces approx. 20,000cylinders per day (284 MT) per day. Bulk LPG is received by LPG tankers and will be stored at 03 Mounded Bullet. The storage capacity will be increased with 03 Proposed new Mounded Bullet (500 MT each) will be 1500 MT. Before installing the Mounded Bullet, the HPCL JAMMU unit was operating with 04 above ground Bullets with

a capacity of 570 MT only. (2 numbers bullets of 150 MT and remaining 2 numbers of 135 MT capacity only).

But After Commissioning of 03 Mounded Bullet, the 04 above ground Bullet will be discontinued and the total storage capacity of HPCL, JAMMU Bottling Plant will be 1500MT. The plant is situated in SIDCO industrial Complex area covered by major industries.

# CLASSIFICATION OF EMERGENCIES (ERDMP-CLAUSE NO 6.0) AND SCHEDULE OF IMPLEMENTATION OF CODE OF PRACTICE FOR ERDMP (ERDMP-CLAUSE NO-7)

#### (a) GENERAL NATURE OF THE HAZARD

In LPG Bottling Plant, LPG is handled, which is highly inflammable and explosive. Hence main risks involved in the plant are fire and explosion. Any small fire in the installation, if not extinguished immediately, can cause large-scale damage and may have a cascading effect. Hence, LPG bottling plant requires.

- A quick responsive containment and control system requiring well planned safety and firefighting system.
- Well-organized trained manpower to handle the process equipment & systems safely.
- Well trained personnel to handle safety and firefighting equipment to extinguish fire inside the installation promptly as well as tackle any type of emergency.

## Hazardous areas of the plant

The plant activities handling LPG can be subdivided into following sections:

However, risk varies due to varying inventory of the material and operations involved. Accordingly, the areas may be listed in order of decreasing risk and the nature of hazard as given below as per results of risk analysis.

The damage potential of the above sections has been discussed in detail in the chapter on Risk Analysis. The credible hazard scenarios are found to be gasket failure, mechanical seal failure of pumps, road tanker unloading arm failure and small bore pipe line failure etc.

Apart from the above, fire cannot be ruled out in substation & MCC as well as in other places from short circuiting and also secondary fire from nearby industries.

However, major accident may occur in the plant and call for emergency/disaster

#### (b) CLASSIFICATION OF EMERGENCIES (ERDMP-CLAUSE NO 6.0)

ERDMP has been developed to deal with emergency incidents which occur within the premises of Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited, JAMMULPG Plant within its jurisdiction. Emergency incidents will be classified by the level of response that will be required. The actual classification will be made by the Officer in Charge (OIC) or his nominee as information first becomes available on an incident. The level of response may change as more information becomes available or conditions change. Where information is lacking the worst case scenario will dictate the level of response.

In Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited, JAMMULPG Plant under its jurisdiction, probable emergencies can be categorized into three broad levels on the basis of seriousness and response requirements, which are given as under:-

**Level - 1 Emergency:** This is an emergency or an incident which can be effectively and safely managed, and contained within the site, location or installation by the available resources. It has no impact outside the site, location or installation.

Following events are considered as Level - 1 Emergencies in the Organisation.

- 1. LPG Hose burst and leakage in Filling Shed.
- 2. Cylinder Body Leak
- 3. TRV/PAV pop up
- 4. Filling Gun or Gas Stop valve failure
- 5. LPG Pump Mechanical seal failure
- 6. Leakage of product line valves
- 7. Hose leakage or failure during Cold Flaring in CR Shed

**Level- 2 Emergency:** This is an emergency or an incident which cannot be effectively and safely managed or contained at the site, location or installation by available resource and additional support is required. It is having, or has the potential to have an effect beyond the site, location or installation and where external support of mutual aid partner may be involved. It is likely to be danger to life, to the environment, to company assets or reputation.

Following events are considered as **Level - 2** Emergencies in the organisation.

- 1. Storage vessel SRV pop up
- 2. Failure of product pipeline leading to leakage
- 3. Bush/dry grass fires during peak summers.
- 4. Leakage during draining operation.

**Level- 3 Emergency:** This is an emergency or an incident which could be catastrophic and is likely to affect the population, property and environment inside and outside the installation, and management and control is done by District Administration

Following events are considered as of Level - 3 Emergencies in the organisation

- 1. Bursting of Storage bullets resulting in heavy leakage leading to BLEVE.
- 2. Agitation / forced entry by external group of people.
- 3. Natural Perils Earthquake
- 4. Sabotage, Bomb explosion / Threat

Important Note: - The earlier emergency classification at plant as per OISD-117 has been renamed as per PNGRB Regulation- 2010 as follows.

#### Risk & Disaster

- We may reveal that use of Mounded Bullet have less risk than an above ground Bullet.
- Due to catastrophic failure made by any Bombing on LPG Road tanker, BLEVE will takes place and the heat wave of 04KW/M2 area will reach the distance of <u>275 Meter</u>. It means during that condition, all the employee is to be evacuated through Security Gate and taken to <u>280Meter distance away from the plant</u>. Before complete evacuation, the push bottom provided near Road Tanker unloading area is to be operated and all ROVs are to be closed safely. All Pumps and Compressor are to be stopped. Chief Incident Controller will inform to Circle Police Inspector,—Jammu, Telephone no-01923-21835 to vacate all the employees of the factories from HPCL

- LPG plant. Though there will be very rare chance of Bombing on above ground Bullet.
- Due to catastrophic failure of Road Tanker at LPG unloading area due to over pressure with the help of entry of high pressure Vapour, the heat wave at 0.2 Bar pressure will reach the distance of 228 Meter. It means the entire employee is to be evacuated and taken to outside of 230 Meter distance. Before complete evacuation, the push bottom provided near Road Tanker unloading area is to be operated and all ROVs are to be closed safely. All Pumps and Compressor are to be stopped. In this case also Chief Incident Controller will inform Circle Police Inspector,—Jammu, Telephone no-01923-21835 to vacate all the employees of the factories installed at the west side of HPCL LPG plant
- In other cases as mentioned above, the plant authority has to take care to evacuate people from 100Meter and below.
- HPCLJAMMU LPG plant has only 02 sets of Self Contain Breathing apparatus (Oxygen filled) with only one spare cylinder of 30 minutes capacity. The management of HPCLJAMMU LPG plant should purchase 03 more Self Contain breathing apparatus (SCBA set) and should give vigorous training to their employee to take action in emergency i.e. say operating Push Bottom, Stopping all LPG Pump and Compressors and ROV quickly.
- Regular Mock Drill is to be organised minimum at least once in six months to take action on evacuation of working personal with all vehicles from the plant.
- During Mock drill, the entire staff, after closing all the operation & maintenance jobs should assemble at Assembly Places with proper head counting. The Emergency Control Centre operated inside the plant should be activated.
- Vigorous training to be given to all employees for carrying out firefighting in emergency inside the Plant against above fire & explosion.

We have described important Risk area with potential emergency although HPCL follow all the norms prescribed by OISD and regulatory body. Audit being conducted, it is suggested by SEAC to integrate our HPCL ERDMP with District ERDMP. Therefore we are submitting complete ERDMP along with this short note as desired by SEAC.
