

Report on State Level Mock Exercise Held on Delhi on 28-03-2024

INTRODUCTION

Delhi is vulnerable to Natural Disaster as well as human induced disaster such as earthquake, flood, urban flood, water logging, bomb blast, acts of terrorism, fires, industrial and chemical hazards, building collapse, road accidents, etc. The entire region of Delhi comes in Seismic Zone IV, at high risk to earthquake as gathered from the earthquake hazard map given in the Vulnerability Atlas of India 2001, and can face an earthquake of 5.5 to 6.7 on Richter Scale (MSK intensity VIII).

The terrain of Delhi is flat in General except for a low NNE-SSW trending ridge which is considered as extension of the Aravalli hills, Seismicity around Delhi appears to be associated with a major geological structure which is known as the Delhi-Haridwar Ridge. It coincides with the extension of the Aravalli Mountain belt beneath the alluvial plains of the Ganga Basin to the North East of Delhi towards the Himalayan Mountain.

Considering its need of the hour, a State Level Mega Mock Exercise on Earthquake Disaster was jointly organized by the Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Government of NCT of Delhi and National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India on 28th March 2024. Before the final mock exercise orientation and table top exercise was also conducted.

AIM

The aim of the exercise was to:

- To check the preparedness and coordination between different Stakeholders.
- To know the strength of various Stakeholders in terms of Manpower, functioning of equipments/ machineries etc.
- Evolve viable response plans

Objectives

- To review
- The preparedness & response times of different Emergency Support Functionaries (ESFs) in the State as well as districts of Delhi for any disasters and to identify areas for further improvement.
 - Ensure coordination among Emergency Support Functions at the District level.
 - Disaster Management Plans and associated SOP of the NCT of Delhi and its District, ESFs as well as individual DM plan of each department in every District.
 - Shortfall and gaps (if any) in resources, manpower, equipment, communications & systems capabilities.
 - Generate public awareness by involving media, LGBs (local Governing bodies), NGOs and community.
 - Hospitals preparedness – cope with casualties, surge capacity, emergency.
 - Ability to receive assistance and aid through road and air.

Stage-1 Orientation and Co-ordination Conference

Coordination and Orientation Conference was organized by Delhi Disaster Management Authority in collaboration with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) for Delhi, through physical Mode, on 14th March, 2024 at 10:00 A.M.

a-Aim:- To discuss and outline the detailed modalities and preparation required for the mock exercise

b-Venue:- Conference Hall of Divisional Commissioner at 5- Sham Nath Marg, New Delhi

This conference was attended by all disaster related functionaries of the NCT of Delhi, districts and representative of Central agencies, forces and paramilitary forces. Brig. B.S.Thakar, Sr. Consultant, NDMA discussed and briefed about the broad programme on conduct of State Level Mock Exercise on Earthquake.

c-Conduct :- Orientation and Co-ordination Conference started from the welcome remarks by Spl. CEO, DDMA and formal introduction by all the participants. Then Brig Thakkar started discussion on the overall scenario for the Mock exercise.

He simulated hypothetical scenario

“A major earthquake of M7.1 occurred at 09:03 AM on E* day with epicentre in Haridwar, Uttarakhand which is very strongly felt in NCT of Delhi Followed by aftershocks of earthquake of M6.9”. Evidence of loss of life and building damage all across, Entire NCT of Delhi is badly affected. Wide spread destruction reported from many areas. Reports pouring in the governmental/ residential/ market complex have been damaged and developed cracks as also there were outbreaks of fires. Danged of triggering Industrial (Chemical) accidents in industries. Injured shifted to hospitals. Capacities overwhelmed. Landline and mobile phone are not working. Planned staging area, relief camp and other IRS infrastructure need to be activated earliest.

Types of Damages observed

- **Unreinforced Stone Masonry Buildings**

Significant number of casualties and injuries in the rural areas associated with the total collapse of single story unreinforced earthen wall stone masonry buildings

- **Unreinforced Brick Masonry Buildings**

30% of the buildings collapsed, rest suffered slight to moderate damage

- **RCC Framed Buildings**

Many soft/weak story failures are observed

Larger multistory buildings with non-ductile reinforced concrete frame, construction with non-structural in-fill block or brick walls reported to have been damaged significantly at many places

Direct Consequences

- People, living in houses falling within the Intensity Zone VII-VIII (MSK), may face serious injury and trauma
- May have to abandon house and property due to complete or partial collapse of the dwellings and be rendered homeless
- Secondary effects (e.g. fires) likely to impose additional economic loss and casualties
- State Resources – stretched to the limit. May require central assistance

At commencement, Sh. Sushil Singh, Special CEO (DM) welcomed all the officers from the Armed Forces, Deputy Commissioners (DCs) and all State/ District level officers from various departments of Delhi Government, then he emphasizing the importance of mock exercises and readiness for the NCT of Delhi.

Brig Thakar then provided a prelude to this tabletop exercise, briefly describing the sequencing and modalities of various disaster situations and scenarios developed at the state level and to be presented to District Administration/ line departments. DCs/ line departments were expected to elicit actions and generate appropriate responses.

Special CEO (DM) requested Sh. Ata Hasnain, NDMA for his opening remarks:

India Meteorological Department (IMD)

Dr. H.S. Mandal, Scientist represents Indian Meteorological Department discussed about the challenges faced after any disaster i.e. rescue team, relief camp etc. He also discussed about vulnerability of Delhi with respect to old structures buildings.

Delhi Fire Services

Delhi Fire Service (DFS) discussed about Hazard and vulnerability index for Delhi. Response mechanism of Delhi Fire Services, Delhi is divided in 3 zones, 6 divisions & 18 Sub divisions. For the response, DFS has 66 Fire Stations in Delhi, three fully equipped Disaster Management Centres at Rohini, Nehru Place and Laxmi Nagar. They have special equipments Hydraulic, electric and pneumatically operated cutters, spreaders, Rams, Combi Tools, inflatable light Masts, Pulling and lifting tools, search cameras, thermal imaging cameras. Breathing apparatus sets, airline, fire suits.

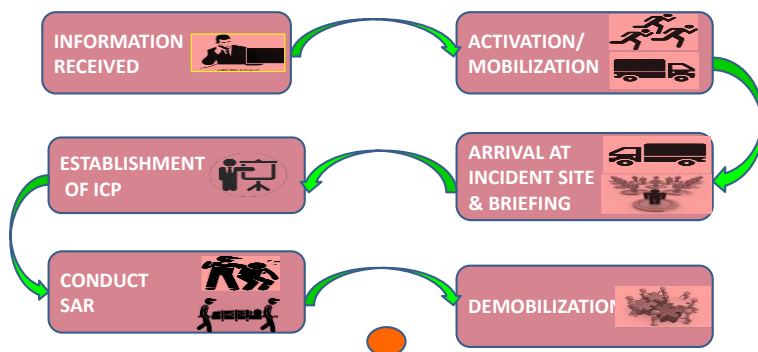
Resources planned for deployment at Mock Drills are

- Water tender shall be deployed in each districts
- One small vehicle/QRT etc shall be deployed in each district
- Rescue tender shall be deployed
- All officers shall be on standby
- If any actual fire call happens in between the resources can be called off

National Disaster Response Force

8th and 16th bat NDRF participated in mock exercise. NDRF deployed each team in every districts. They also provided eight observers for eight Districts.

Response Mechanism



Communication



Sh. Neeraj, Commandant, NDRF briefed about the role & response of NDRF during any disaster. He also stated that NDRF is single largest force in the world for quick response after occurring of any disaster. In India, NDRF has 16 battalions as of now and 1049 personnel, 18 self-contained team- specialized in search and rescue, 9 CBRN teams. Each team has 47 personnel with 2 dogs. NDRF team consists Medical, Logistic, Management, Search, Rescue personnel's. In normal hours, NDRF conducts awareness programmes/ mock exercises in communities, schools etc.

Health & Family Welfare

Dr. Sanjay, CMO, representative from Directorate of Health Services (DHS) discussed that there are 11 CDMOs in Delhi (01 in each district). CDMO is also one of the member of District DMA Committee. There is a Quick Response Team (QRT) having one Medical Officer, one Pharmacist & one Nurse on 24*7 basis who can respond to every incident occurred in the district (The same protocol is being followed by every hospital). The Team also have Emergency Kit with them. Hospitals have their Disaster Management Plan regarding SOPs. Hospitals also have designated disaster ward.

Delhi Metro Rail Corporation

Shri Prem Singh Rathore, Addl. General Manager/Operations described preparedness of DMRC. He informed DMRC Stations, Depots, buildings including Ancillary buildings are designed as per NBC. DMRC structures designed to handle Earthquake intensity of M 7.0.

SOP prepared and practiced to check system after Earthquake settles. JPO is prepared to specifies the precautions and care to be taken by all the concerned staff of DMRC. Operations Control Centre (OCC) is the overall in-charge of handling any such occurrences.

DMRC has installed Five Earthquake Warning System through CSIO-CSIR to detect earthquake;

- Metro Bhawan (MB)
- Mundka (Line-5)
- Sushant Lok (Line-2)
- Botanical Garden (Line3)
- Faridabad Sec-46 (Line-6)

Worst case Scenario

Earthquake severity being detected as strong (PGA values being above 0.18) through EQWS system;

- Train services remain suspended.
- Announcement being made at station and inside Trains.
- Trains at station platform shall be evacuated.
- Power supply is Switched off whenever required.
- Preparation of methodology for carrying inspection by concerned department.
- Detailed examination of track and structure including overhead equipment.

Telecom Authorities

Sriphal Meena, Assistant Director General, Deptt of Telecommunications, Govt Of India explains existing telecom network, and there elements. Natural Hazards & Climate Events- Impact on Telecom Infra structure. He also discussed key reasons of telecom network failure during disaster.

He assures infra structure Resilience and Redundancy by

- Comply with norms and standards in building physical infrastructure
- Critical equipment not concentrated in one building
- Telecommunication equipment to be able to withstand impacts of any disaster
- Adequate fire protection measures
- Comply with building bylaws prescribed for earthquake resistant building depending upon seismic zones
- Transmission links between main network elements and switching elements to follow distinct geographical paths

DMRC Emergency communication plans SOP & DMP

- Role of DoT to act as Primary agency for Emergency Support Function (ESF) relating to telecommunication services by Telecom Service Providers and coordination with other Government agencies.
- SOP-2020 for telecommunication services for responding to disaster formulated in view of provisions of National DM Policy, National Digital Telecommunication Policy (NTP)-2012
- Directions from MHA that that every Ministry/ Department of the GoI shall formulate SOP and DMP

IGL

Naveen Kumar Sharma, Sr Manager, PNG O&M, IGL gave presentation.

As per PNGRB Gazette Notification GSR 39 (E) LEVELS OF EMERGENCIES ...L1, L2, L3

Level 1: This is an emergency or an incident which -

- Can be effectively and safely managed and contained within the site, location or installation by the available resources;
- Has no impact outside the site, location or installation.

Level 2: This is an emergency or an accident which –

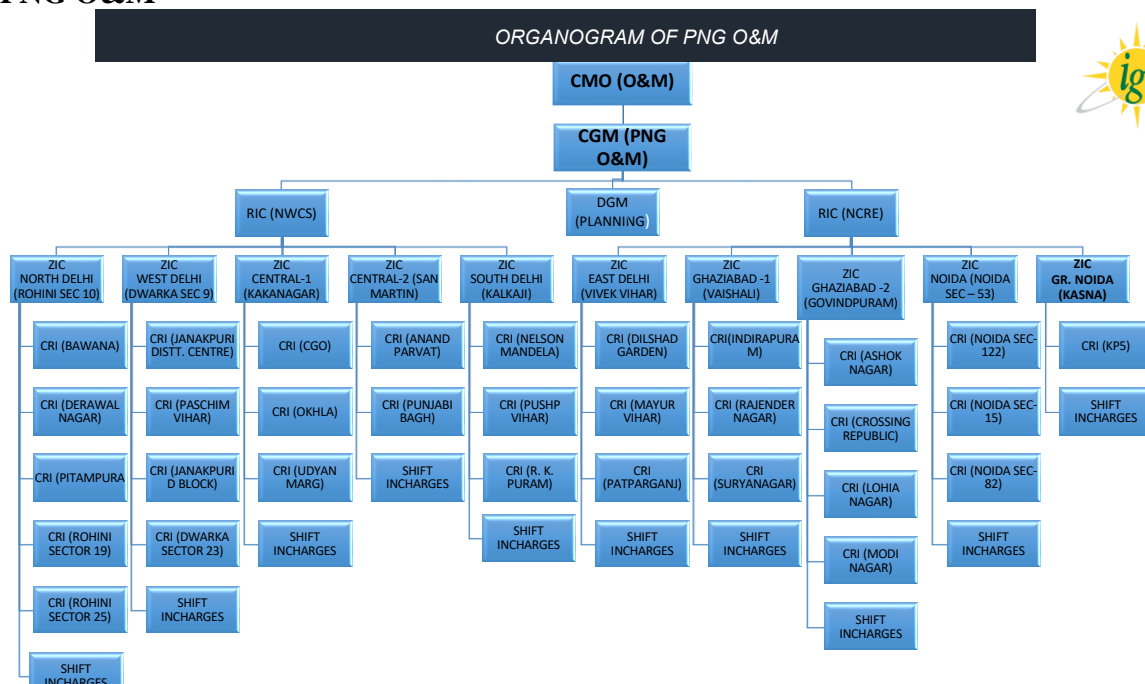
- Cannot be effectively and safely managed or contained at the location or installation by available resources and additional support is alerted or required;
- Is having or has the potential to have an effect beyond the site , location or installation and where external support of mutual aid partner may be involved.
- Is likely to be danger to life, the environment or to industrial assets or reputation.

Level 3: This is an emergency, incident with off-site impact which could be catastrophic and is likely to affect the population, property and environment inside and outside the installation, and management and control is done by district administration. Although the Level-III emergency falls under the purview of District Authority but till they step in. it should be responsibility of the unit to manage the emergency.

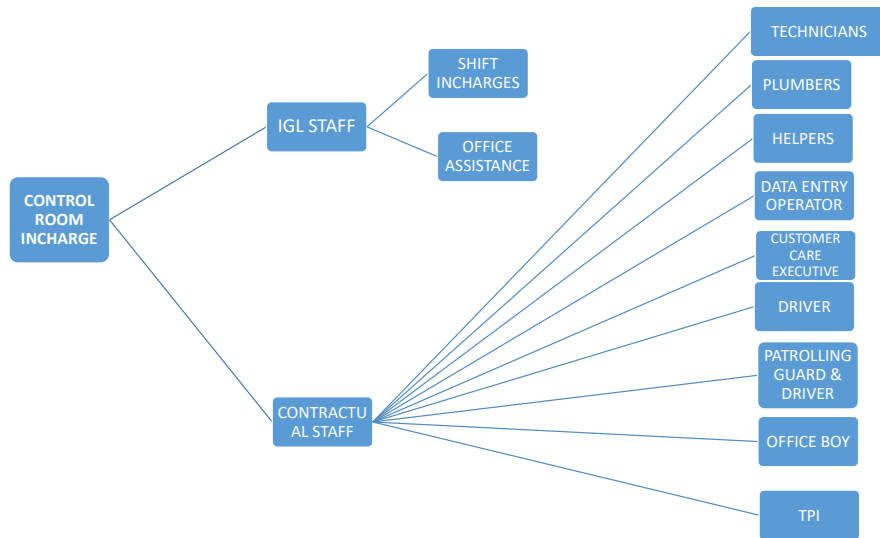
District South West

DDMA (South West) discussed about their preparation for Mock Exercise. They also conducted mock exercise at district level to check the preparedness of various line departments. In summarizing the conference, Special CEO (DM) stated that this mock exercise is required to update and revise the State, District and Departmental Disaster Management Plans to address mega-disasters and mass level emergencies. Furthermore, there is an urgent need to implement the NDMA Guidelines and the roles assigned to IRTs and Departments handling ESFs. It is important to conduct such exercises on a regular basis to improve coordination and response time and thus reduce loss and damage to life and property.

The meeting was concluded by Sh. Sushil Singh, Special CEO (DM) by emphasizing that this mock exercise must be carried out with extreme caution and safety.

NDRF

On the day of Mock Exercise, NDRF exhibits different equipments for communication, search and rescue and other support activities at DDMA HQ.



HAM Radio

Amateur Radio also known as HAM radio. HAM radio is a non-commercial two way communication. Messages are sent either by voice or in international morse code. Communication is on HF VHF direct and through repeater. HAM radio displayed by organization of Disaster Managers, New Delhi

Organization of Disaster Managers (ODM) is a community-based organization dedicated to equipping individuals with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively respond to disasters and emergencies. Located in Dwarka societies, ODM offers specialized disaster management training tailored to different demographics, including senior citizens, children, working professionals, and housewives.



Drone



Drone helps rescue workers find lost people more quickly. It helps search hard-to-reach regions, like peaks, damaged buildings, etc., for missing people or animals. Drones equipped with multispectral sensors are essential in search and rescue missions due to their ability to detect body heat. Drone help for situational Analysis.

Mock Exercise 28-3-24

Preparatory Actions: Before the conduct of the exercise many actions were taken by the State Disaster Management Authority and District Disaster Management Authorities to engage the stakeholders for the Mock Exercise. A WhatsApp group was also created with all the members of the State IRT, Observers and the staff of District DMAs.

Posters and other information material regarding the Mock Exercise were also circulated through WhatsApp groups and other social media platforms. **(placed at Annexure III)**

A State Level Mock Exercise on Earthquake Disaster covering all 11 districts of Delhi was triggered at 9:03 A.M. on 28th March, 2024. The list of participants at State Headquarters is placed at **Annexure IV**.

State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC): The National Disaster Management Authority reported the occurrence of hypothetical Earthquake of magnitude 7.7 on the Richter Scale at 9:03 A.M. The first response was to “**Duck, Cover, Hold**” and evacuation. After ensuring safety of everyone on site, the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) was activated

immediately having communication system like Wireless system, VSAT, ERSS, fixed line phones, HAM radio, computers and laptops and State Incident Response Team members were informed about the earthquake. Simultaneously, all the District EOCs were contacted and the report of the damage and loss were sought by the SEOC both through wireless sets and landlines.

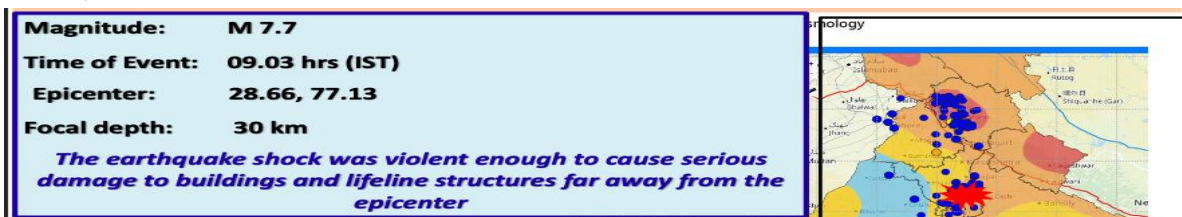
Establishment of Sections of IRS: Different sections of the IRS were established; such as Planning Section, Operation Section & Logistic Section. The IRT members/representatives were deployed in their respective sections for the coordination with the districts for assessment of damage and loss reports and effective response. Chief Observers from ITBP, NDRF, Army, Medical, CRPF and CISF were deployed in the State EOC as well as in the districts. The list of Observers is placed at the **Annexure V** and the Reporting Format for Observers is placed at **Annexure VI**.

The Communication Network

Network for communications such as landline, mobile etc. were shown down and reports of damage & loss were received through Police wireless networks. The reports were tabulated in Wireless Section on hourly basis and thereafter shared with Logistic and Planning Sections. The district-wise reports were also compiled at State EOC compilation section. Satellite phones, drones and HAM radio were also used during this exercise. This time Zylo app was also downloaded by the District DM and DDMA H.Q to communicate in case of emergency.

The Exercise: The Mock Exercise was conducted at 55 locations in Delhi. Five sites for mock drill and one staging area were identified in each district. List of the sites where mock exercise was triggered by the SEOC is placed at **Annexure VII**.

Mock scenario: An earthquake of 7.7 magnitude has struck Delhi at 9:03A.M. on 24th March, 2023.



V-SAT for communication

V-SAT: After the earthquake, DDMA took first action to connect the affected sites and multiple other sites quickly by using V-SAT. The NDMA was informed about the damages and other information from various districts. North-East Delhi, NDRF, MHA.

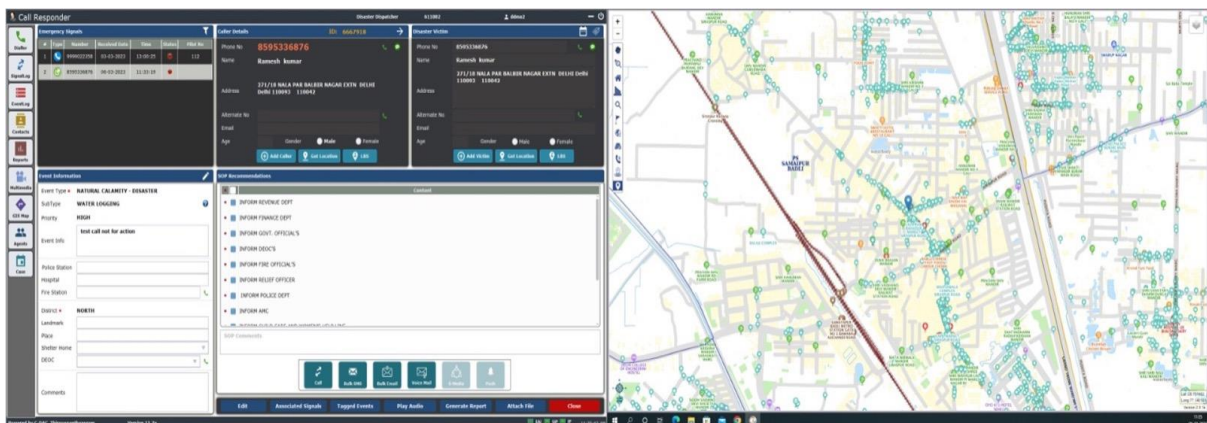


Wireless Static Set

Wireless communication takes place over free space through RF (radio frequency), one device, a **Transmitter**, sends signal to another device, a **Receiver**. Two devices (transmitter and receiver) must use same frequency (or channel) to be able to communicate with each other. If a large number of wireless devices communicate at same time, radio frequency can cause interference with each other. Interference increases as no of devices increases.

Emergency Response Support System (ERSS)

ERSS is a Pan-India single number (112) based emergency response system for citizens in emergencies. This number was mobilised as a resource for emergency assistance and the calls received through this portal were responded immediately.



Once the District EOCs were activated, the DMs & District IRTs established the Staging Area, Relief Camps, Command Posts in affected areas and Camps for Responders respectively. All

progress and due actions were co-ordinated with the State EOC through satellite communication. The district wise list of Nodal Officers along with Incident Commanders is placed at **Annexure VIII**.

Live streaming was also done in all districts through video conferencing which was streamed at the State EOC in DDMA HQ. Live streaming was observed by the observers at State EOC. Further Mock Exercise was observed by the Observers at district level also. List is placed at **Annexure IX**. The district wise Observer's report is placed at **Annexure X**.

Inspection of sites: Three mock drill sites and one staging area were visited by Sh. Sushil Singh, Special CEO (DM) and Brig.Thakar, Consultant, NDMA along with a panel of other dignitaries. This visit was used as an opportunity to see the districts in action during the mock exercise and any observations or corrective measures were then shared with the respective districts during the debriefing session. The Mock exercise was called off at 1:30 P.M.

Debriefing Session

A debriefing session was held through Video Conference (VC) with all 11 districts along with their Observers and the State IRT members at 3.00 pm on same day under the Chairmanship of Special CEO (DM). The session commenced in the presence of Brig. Thakkar, Consultant, NDMA and other dignitaries from NDRF, Officers of the Armed Forces, and various officers of the State Government.

The Special CEO (DM) asked the DMs from each district to provide a brief report about the conduct of mock exercise in their respective districts, with a focus on lessons learnt and recommendations.

Observations

1. Since the districts were informed of the exercise earlier, respective teams were already placed at the incident sites beforehand, which is not a representation of an actual scenario since there will be no prior information in case of an emergency.
2. At most of the incident sites medical post was not available, however Ambulance was placed.
3. In some districts relief centers were not there and incident command post was not installed.
4. There was paucity of space in staging area, staging area should be large so that every resource can be placed.
5. At 09.03 am situation was told but within 2 minutes at some places, vehicles were moving, this is not representative of a real time situation.
6. Transport issue was observed in some cases.
7. Participation of all stakeholders was not as enthusiastic.
8. The functionaries of IRS are not aware of their roles and responsibilities.
9. Overall, there was lack of coordination. Everybody was working on independent mode.

Suggestions and Recommendations

1. Limited information to be imparted to the districts and related departments, so that better simulation of real time situation can be done.
2. Capacity building of CDVs, NYKS, Aapda Mitra to enhance their skills and train them better for emergency situations.
3. When landline and other modes of communication is down, bike riders can be used to rally information, V-sat communication also to be strengthened at district level.
4. EOCs should have independent communication systems of their own. Wireless sets, HAM radio can also be used. NDRF has QDA system. State EOC as well as District Authorities should acquire that as it does not require an internet connection.
5. Department wise mock drill can also be done.
6. EOC should have connectivity in the NDMA room with the natural EOC in MHA. Each district should have an alternate EOC, replicated with all new structure. EOC should have a data wall – GIS base system operation, map of all the areas- Hospital, roads whatever resources are present should be mapped on the wall.

7. In EOC, there should be duty roster for 24*7 working. Logbook should be there; entry of every event should be made.
8. In case no power supply is there, districts must have adequate generators and diesel also.
9. More involvement of media is required
10. Raise an SDRF, NDRF might take time to respond
11. The concept of staging area needs to be clearer, a staging area manager to be assigned to ensure efficient functioning.
12. Relief camps should be made keeping certain pointers in mind such as: cooking hygiene, sanitation, gender segregation, special needs of children, lactating mothers, old people and physically handicapped.
13. Every district is supposed to have an NGO cell and map their capabilities.
14. Next exercise was suggested in two months' time after filling the loopholes noticed in this exercise.

The debriefing session was then concluded by closing remarks from Special CEO (DM). He congratulated all the stakeholders on successful completion of the Mock Exercise and thanked NDMA for providing with the necessary handholding for the same.
