## Background

- **Ad-hoc CAMPA was constituted in 2006 as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 29<sup>th</sup> October 2001 for management of Compensatory levies.**
- **Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF) Act, 2016 and Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF) Rules, 2018, became effective w.e.f. 30.09.2018.**
- **National Authority came into existence to replace Ad-hoc CAMPA.**
- **33 State/UT Authorities have been created.**

## Manner of Utilization of State Fund (Section 6, CAF Act)

- **Site-specific Activities(Mandatory):** included at the time of FC proposal
  - ✓ Compensatory Afforestation (CA)
  - ✓ Catchment Area Treatment (CAT) Plan
  - ✓ Wildlife Management Plan
  - ✓ Any other site-specific scheme
  
- **Non-site-specific Activities (Non-Mandatory):**
  - proposed at the time of APO preparation
  - ✓ Net Present Value (NPV)
  - ✓ Interest

## Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF) Rules, 2018

### Activities proposed under NPV Components

1. Rule 5(2)(f) - Forest Fire Prevention & Control Operation,
2. Rule 5(3)(d) - Fire lines & Construction of Watch Towers

## Activities proposed under Forest Fire Prevention & Control Operations

### **Activities** proposed by State/UTs of CAMPA

- ✓ Forest fire prevention and control operations
- ✓ Fire watchers
- ✓ Fire fighting equipment's
- ✓ Construction of Watch Towers
- ✓ Hiring of vehicles for forest fire response team
- ✓ Forest fire awareness campaigns
- ✓ Forest fire protection squads
- ✓ Creation of forest fire lines and maintenance

**Above activities shall be included in the State Fire Management Plan of their State APOs,**

- **The activities must be part of Integrated Management Plans and clearly indicate funding support is available from CSSs of Ministry and others to avoid duplication.**
- **The non-recurring expenditure shall be utilized for forest fire management activities along with CAMPA Fund.**
- **Judicious use of CAMPA Fund for forest protection, public awareness and capacity building for Forest fire prevention and control operations.**
- **The funds approved for Forest Fire Management not being utilised by state Authorities in a timely manner.**

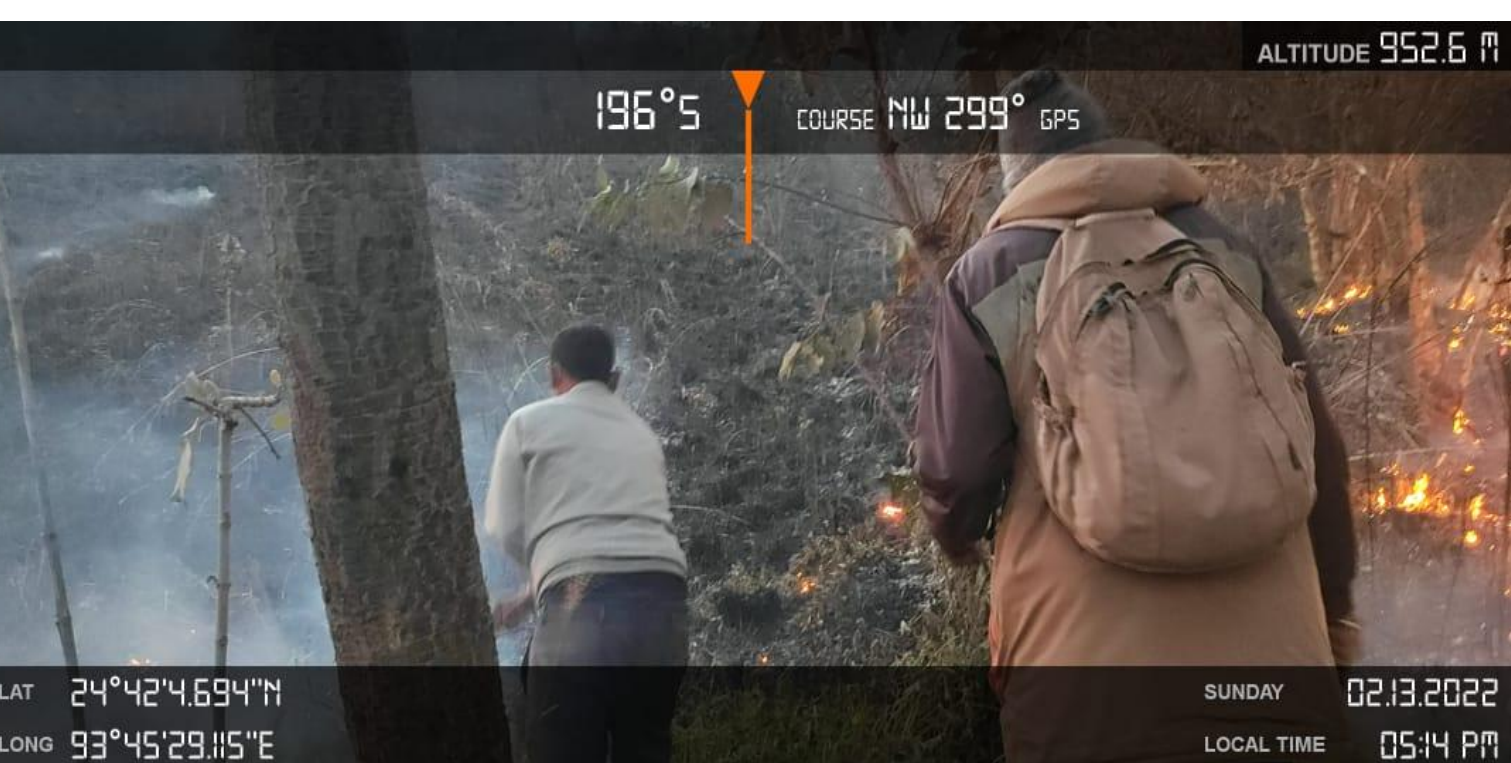

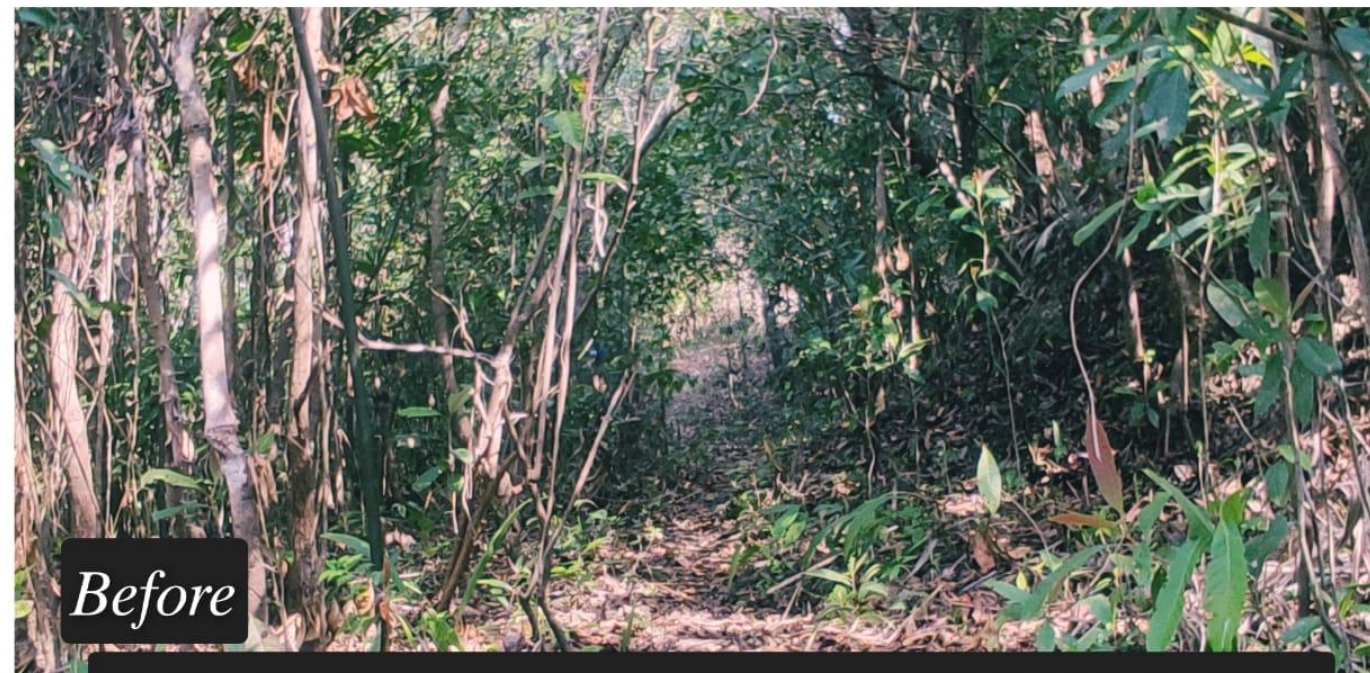

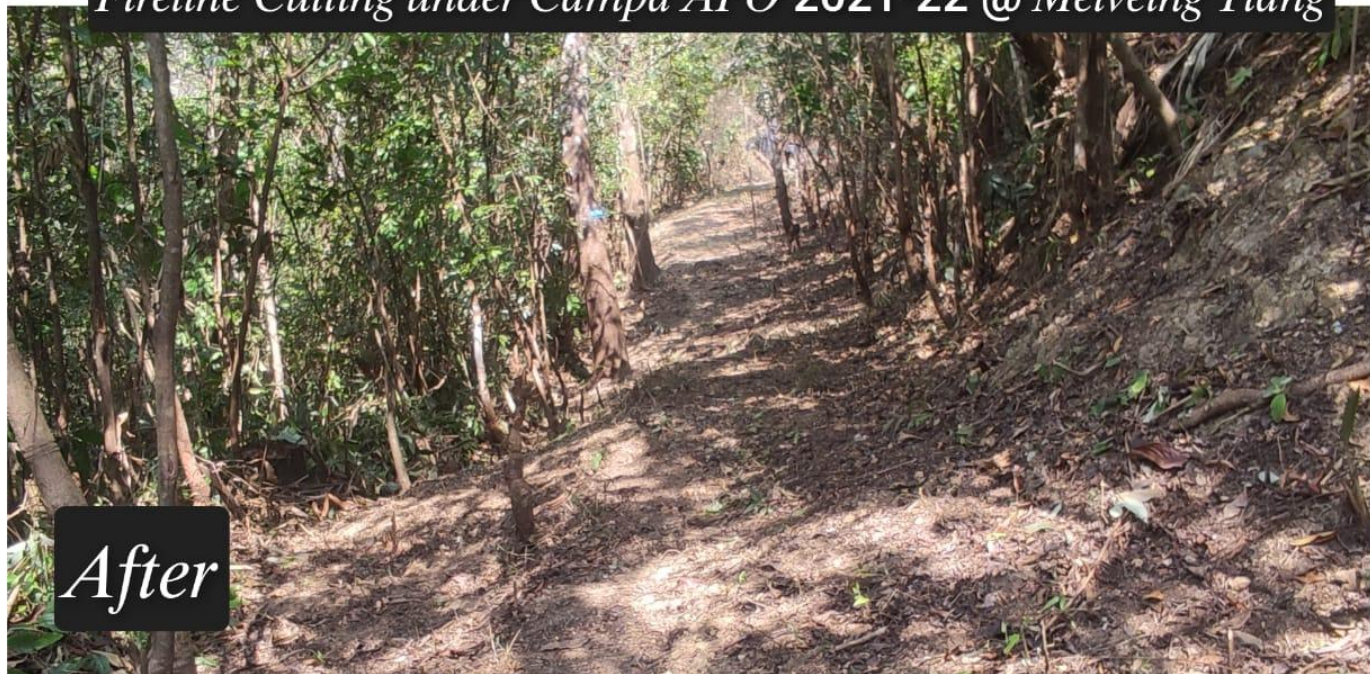
